NOVEMBER

1800: Congress holds its first session in the partially completed U.S. Capitol building.

1872: Suffragist Susan B. Anthony is fined for voting in the presidential election.

1919: President Woodrow Wilson declares the first Armistice Day. It would later become a federal holiday and its name changed to Veterans Day.

1927: Linking New York City and New Jersey under the Hudson River, the Holland Tunnel opens to the public.

1939: The cornerstone is laid for the Jefferson Memorial in Washington, D.C.

1947: Business tycoon and aviator Howard Hughes flies his massive wooden airplane, the Spruce Goose, over California's Long Beach Harbor. It would be the aircraft's only flight.

1955: Muppets creator Jim Henson registers the copyright for Kermit the Frog.

1969: Apollo 12 completes NASA's second manned mission to the moon.

1982: Michael Jackson's album "Thriller" is released. It stands as the best-selling album of all time.

1995: The national maximum speed limit of 55 mph is repealed, allowing individual states to set their own speed limits.

2004: Condoleezza Rice is nominated to be secretary of state by President George W. Bush. She was the first African-American woman to serve in the Cabinet position.

2007: Amazon introduces the Kindle, a portable electronic device for downloading and reading digital books. It sold out in five hours.
