To ensure that all festival goers have a safe and fun time, below is a list of what's allowed and not allowed. The Great American Beer Festival has a "no re-entry" policy. **21+ Only.**

Empty, CLEAR, reusable, plastic water bottles

*Example:
Nalgene bottle (32 oz. or less)*



Fanny packs, purses & bags
6" x 6" x 12" and smaller



Pretzel Necklaces



Costumes

Full face masks and props resembling weapons are prohibited.



Event management reserves the right to handle each occurrence on a case by case basis.

Lockers and other onsite storage are not available.

Smoking inside the Convention Center is prohibited
(including the use of e-cigarettes or vape pens)

A smoking area is available on the loading dock of Hall A.

All bags, jackets and guests are subject to search upon entering the event.

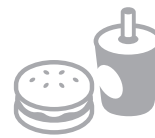
