# FROM NEWARK

## CHARTER BUS to & from Newark International Airport

We are offering charter bus service to and from the airport this year. If you can arrange your flights around the below times, this is the easiest way to get to camp.

Bus times:

- Thursday, August 23rd leaves from Newark Airport at 2pm, to reserve your spot [CLICK HERE](#).
- Sunday, August 26th leaves camp at 1:30pm and arrives at Newark around 4:00-4:30pm (depending on traffic), to reserve your spot [CLICK HERE](#).

- Round-trip Tickets, to reserve your seats [CLICK HERE](#).

One way ticket is \$45.00 and round trip is \$85.00

If you will be arriving/departing at other times, not to worry, you can follow the below directions and take the train to camp.

## Getting to Camp from Newark International Airport (EWR) BY TRAIN

1. Upon your safe arrival to EWR Airport, please go to the baggage claim area and collect your baggage and personal belongings.

2. Follow the signs to the AirTrain.

3. Before boarding the AirTrain, purchase your ticket at a NJ Transit ticket vending machine. Follow these Instructions:

- Select NJT rail ticket option
- Enter the station identification number (795) for Middletown, NY (\*\*make sure it says NY and NOT Middletown, New Jersey\*\*)
- The cost of the ticket is \$25.00 one-way

\*\*\*Important: This ticket is used for the AirTrain and all other trains on your journey to camp\*\*\*

4. Board the AirTrain and Exit at Newark International Airport Train Station.

5. Board the next available NJTransit train/ Northeast Corridor Line heading to New York – Penn station. You are NOT going all the way to

NY- Penn. You will get off the train at the 2nd stop/ Secaucus Junction.

6. At Secaucus Junction, transfer to the Metro North train - Main / Bergen / Port Jervis Line. This train will take you to Middletown, NY. (Again, remember Middletown, New York not Middletown, New Jersey).

7. The train from Newark Airport to Camp is less than 2 hours—sit back, relax and enjoy the ride.

8. Complimentary shuttle buses will be available to pick you up at Middletown, NY train station and bring you to camp for the 2:30pm and 4:20pm arrivals.

\* If you arrive later than this, please check the train schedule online and arrange for a taxi to bring you to camp. The taxi should be around \$65.

# TO NEWARK

## GOING HOME BY TRAIN from Middletown, NY to Newark International Airport

by train on Sunday, August 26th  
from Middletown NY to Newark

If your flight is after 6 pm, your best option is to take the charter bus that leaves camp at 1:30 pm and arrives at Newark around 4:00-4:30pm (depending on traffic). To reserve your seat [CLICK HERE](#). If you need to leave earlier in the day, we will be providing transportation to the Middletown train station for the train that leaves at 11:13 am and arrives at Newark Airport at 1:30pm. If you need an earlier train, go to [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com) to see the schedule.

Depending on the train you take, travel time varies from 137-160 minutes.

Remember you will be transferring to another train in Secaucus, NJ before reaching your final destination at Newark International Airport. Also, please allow additional time for the airtrain to get to your terminal.

We were told the train schedule will be the same over the summer, but recommend double checking the schedule closer to camp. To view the train schedule go to:
