

# Hazards Worksheet

Hazard	Evaluation Questions
<b>Struck Against:</b>	Can the worker(s) forcefully strike against anything (sharp edges, protruding objects, machinery, etc.)?
<b>Struck By:</b>	Can anything move and strike the worker(s) abruptly and/or forcefully?
<b>Contact:</b>	Can the worker(s) come in contact with electrically charged equipment?
<b>Caught In:</b>	Can any part of the worker(s) be caught on any object which could pull them into a piece of equipment?
<b>Caught Between:</b>	Can any part of the body be caught between something moving and something stationary or between two moving objects?
<b>Fall/Same Level:</b>	Can the worker(s) slip or trip on anything that would result in a fall?
<b>Fall/Different Level:</b>	Can the worker(s) fall from one level to another?
<b>Overexertion:</b>	Can the worker(s) be injured while lifting, pulling, pushing, twisting, reaching, bending or any other motion resulting in a sprain or strain?
<b>Exposure:</b>	Can the worker(s) be exposed to excessive noise, vibration, extreme temperatures, poor air circulation, toxic gases, airborne dust/fumes or hazardous chemicals?
<b>Engulfment</b>	Can the worker(s) be engulfed/entrapped by material (grain, fertilizer, etc.)?
