COMPETITION RULES

2023 - 2024

CADETS LEAGUE

(under 14 boys) BORN - 2010

PARTICIPATING TEAMS:

First part of the season (till November) – Tournaments bi weekly (no more than 7 players per team).

Games: 2 x 10 min halves; running clock but stopped in last minute only.

2 games per session per team.

No scoresheets kept – visual only.

Refereed by U16 players – under supervision.

Clubs may change the make-up of their teams on a weekly basis.

Full co-operation of all clubs and coaches is necessary if we are to be successful in providing more basketball for the young players.

An early indication of the number of teams who are to participate from each club will allow us to plan weekly fixtures.

Regular league competition

- Minimum of players per team; 8
- 4 sessions of 7 minutes (stopping time) will be played.
- Ball size; 6.
- Up to the 3rd Quarter all players on the bench have to play.
- If a team has less than 12 players on the bench (min. 8), then the opposing team has the option to use an equal number of players by the 3rd quarter.
- Minimum of one FULL quarter to be played by each player. (The above note applies)
- Maximum of three FULL quarters to be played by each player.
- A player cannot play the first 3 consecutive quarters.
- No Substitutions are allowed at any time during the first 3 quarters of the game, with the exceptions of the following:
 - 1. When there are any injured players, subs to be decided by the opposing coach.
 - 2. Fouled out players, subs to be decided by the opposing coach.
 - 3. 4th Quarter, subs are allowed, always abiding by the above mentioned rules.

- Zone defence is not allowed.
- 1. If two or more teams finish with the same number of points at the top of the table a decider will be played.
- 2. 2 points for a win and 1 point for a loss. No points will be awarded to those Teams handing over a walk-over
- 3. The team with the highest number of points at the end of the League will be declared CHAMPION for Season 2023 2024.
- 4. All MBA and FIBA rules apply for this League with the exception of the ones mentioned above.
- 5. A team can field any player whether the player is a foreigner or Maltese. No restrictions on the number of foreigners on court during playing time.

CADETTES LEAGUE

(UNDER 14 GIRLS) BORN - 2010

PARTICIPATING TEAMS:

First part of the season (till November) – Tournaments bi weekly (no more than 7 players per team).

Games: 2 x 10 min halves; running clock but stopped in last minute only.

2 games per session per team.

No scoresheets kept – visual only.

Refereed by U16 players – under supervision.

Regular league competition

- A player cannot play the first 3 consecutive quarters.
- No Substitutions are allowed at any time during the first 3 quarters of the game, with the exceptions of the following:

- 1. When there are any injured players, subs to be decided by the opposing coach.
- 2. Fouled out players, subs to be decided by the opposing coach.
- 3. 4th Quarter, subs are allowed, always abiding by the above mentioned rules.
- Zone defence is not allowed.
- 1. If two or more teams finish with the same number of points at the top of the table a decider will be played.
- 2. 2 points for a win and 1 point for a loss. No points will be awarded to those Teams handing over a walk-over
- 3. The team with the highest number of points at the end of the League (Top 4 Teams) will be declared CHAMPION for Season 2023 2024.


