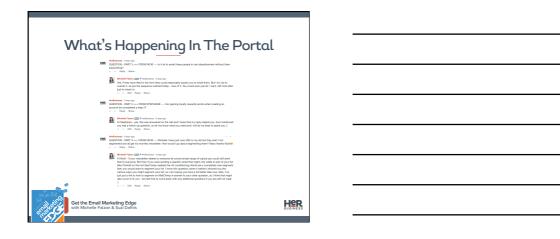

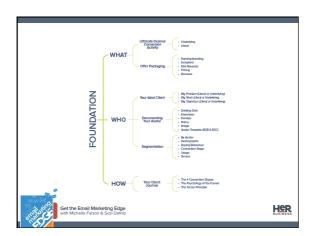
I'm tempted to start the nurture process (reassure) and end with a menu (move forward) over a couple of weeks.

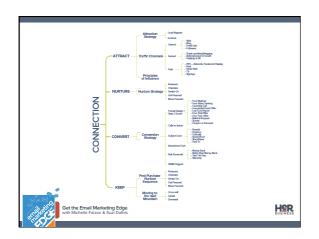

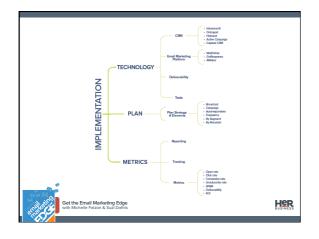

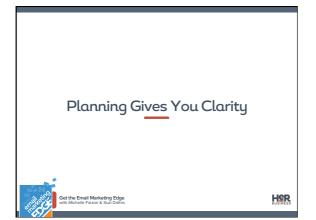

· Broadcast vs Autoresponder?

What's the Difference?

- Broadcast =
 - Specific send date and time
 - Ideal for time-related events eg
 Christmas sale, live training, start of
 the summer detox, store opening
 - Not necessarily based on any action by the recipient



What's the Difference?

- Autoresponder =
 - Automated email sequence triggered by specific actions
 - Can be any length from 1 email to 100 or more
 - Set intervals

• If in an Autoresponder limit or don't send other emails

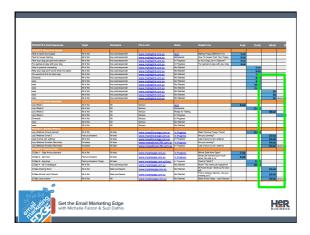


Broadcast Email Planning Process

- Step 3 complete your plan and check for overloads or gaps (see the detail AND the big picture)



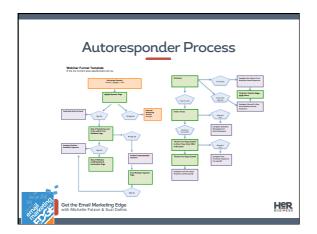

Autoresponder Process

- EG 10-email sequence in first 21 days.
 - Immediate Reassure/Switch On
 - Day 2 Connect/Switch On
 - Day 3 Connect/Switch On/Move Forward
 - Day 5 Orientate/Move Forward
 - Day 7 Connect / Move Forward
 - Day 9 Connect / Move Forward
 - Day 12 Connect / Move Forward
 Day 15 Orientate / Move Forward
 - Day 18 Move Forward
- Day 21 Move Forward / Orientate

Autoresponder Process

- A good quick cart abandonment sequence
 - + 30 mins Email 1
 - 24 hours Email 2
 - 48 hours Email 3



Knowing Your Numbers Gives You Certainty

Knowing Your Numbers - \$

- Two important numbers:
 - Cost Per Lead
 - Revenue Per Lead

Knowing Your Numbers - \$

- Cost Per Lead =
 - \$ spent on advertising / # leads generated

Spent \$1000 / Generated 100 leads

1000/100 = **\$10** Cost Per Lead



Knowing Your Numbers - \$

- Revenue Per Lead =
 - \$ generated / # leads generated

Generated \$2000 Revenue / 100 leads

2000/100 = **\$20** Revenue Per Lead

Knowing Your Numbers - Email

- Open rate (number of people who opened your email as a % of total sent)
- Click rate (number of people who clicked your email as a % of total opened)
- Conversion rate (number of people who took the next step as a % of those who clicked)
- Unsubscribed (number of people who opted out of your list as a % of those sent)
- SPAM (number of people who flagged your message as SPAM as a % of those sent)

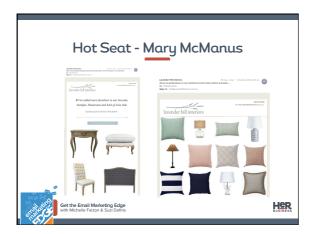
