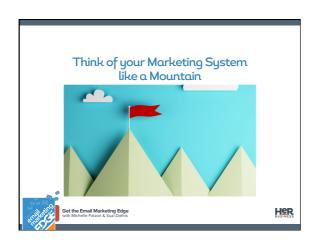

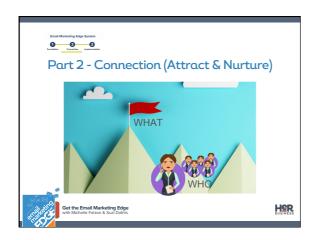




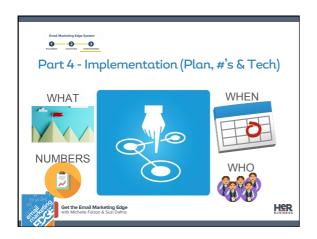














Begin With The End In Mind

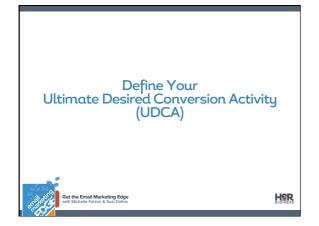
How To Choose Your Mountain

- Has a specific WHAT and a specific WHO
- You might need multiple mountains
- · Choose one to start









Define Your UDCA

- Leveragable
- Will make a significant difference to your business if you sell a lot* of it
- Is **aligned** with your vision/business plan...

Define Your UDCA

- Has sufficient **profit** margin to be **viable** (ask yourself if I had to pay to drive traffic to this mountain would I be able to make money out of it?)
- Has sufficient **demand** (is there a thirsty crowd for this?)...

Define Your UDCA

- Not just literal, but also underlying meaning for your ideal customer - what are you really selling?
- The **WHAT** is much less about the thing (features) and more about the transformation the thing can deliver...



Define Your UDCA

- Make it crystal clear
- Consider "Bundling"
- Consider going "Next Level"...

- A Reason to Buy Now







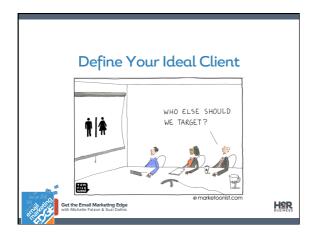
Define Your Ideal Client

- Don't brush over this this is a habit of top marketers. Not just to "tick the box."
- Make it real and meaningful
- OK to polarise
- You want a Tribe
- 80/20 rule...

Define Your Ideal Client

- · Loves what you do
- Profitable
- · Less refunds/customer service hassle
- · Easier to acquire
- Repeat purchases (loyalty)
- Refers people (advocacy)...

Define Your Ideal Client

• Best done by creating your Ideal Client Avatar (sometimes called Buyer Persona)





Why Client Avatar Is Important

- · Client-centred
- Because when a person feels you understand them they will be attracted to you (when you don't understand them, they feel repelled or ambivalent).
- Once you understand what makes your customers tick – you can become the solution they've been looking for...

Why Client Avatar Is Important

- · Speaking "human"
- You understand their objections and concerns - address those specifically in your communication.
- Your copy often "writes itself" when struggling likely you are not clear on your Client Avatar

Why Client Avatar Is Important

- Gives clarity to your business planning. Easier to say yes or no to opportunities. Certainty.
- Reduces cost of sale marketing more targeted, Joint Venture scope, better conversion rate, client retention and attitude toward your business is better – all round awesome sauce!!

- · Drop your assumptions at the door
- Stephen Covey Habit #5 "Seek first to understand, then be understood"
- · ASK Existing Data / Interact
- · Write it down!
- Take the "Imaginative Leap"...

How To Create Your Client Avatar "You can have the best message in the world, but the person on the receiving and will always, undestand it through the prism of his or her own emotions, preconceptions, repludices, and pre-existing beliefs. It's not enough to be correct or reasonable or even brilliant. The key to successful communication is to take the imaginative leap of stuffing yourself right into your listener's shose to know what they are thinking and feeling in the despeta recesses or their mind and heart. How that person perceives what you say is even more real, at least in a practical sense, than how you perceive yourself." How To Create Your Client Avatar

- If B2B you still do your Customer Avatar (people buy from people) AND you also need to do a Company Avatar.
- · "Firmographics"
 - Industry, location, customer size, turnover, status, structure, verticals

Where Do You Get The Data?

- Existing sales records, database, previous surveys, Facebook Insights, customer service, tech support & key team (invaluable), "gut"
- Surveys existing database or find ways to survey prospects eg trade shows, social media following or find online forums or Facebook Groups
- Interviews pick your top 5 ideal clients and take them to lunch or Skype record interview...



USE & Communicate Your Client Avatar

- Put it somewhere you and your team can see it all the time
- Give it to anyone who is working on your marketing - designers, web team, consultants etc.
- Look at it when creating your marketing!!!
