# **Monthly Indicators**



### **July 2016**

Percent changes calculated using year-over-year comparisons.

New Listings were down 17.4 percent for single family homes and 2.0 percent for townhouse-condo properties. Pending Sales landed at 55 for single family homes and 65 for townhouse-condo properties.

The Median Sales Price was down 2.7 percent to \$316,000 for single family homes and 7.0 percent to \$200,000 for townhouse-condo properties. Days on Market decreased 34.1 percent for single family homes but increased 16.2 percent for condo properties.

Sales momentum is slow, but this has not been unexpected. Buyers want to get into the market, but unlike the rising-price sales environment of ten years ago, people are not diving headlong into risky mortgages or uncomfortable situations. This carefulness should be celebrated, not feared. Even as employment figures remain positive, wages increase and mortgage rates hover around all-time lows, consumers are holding for the right deal. As sellers and builders increase their own level of confidence, we should see greater activity in Q2 2016. The second quarter tends to rank as the best time to list a home for sale.

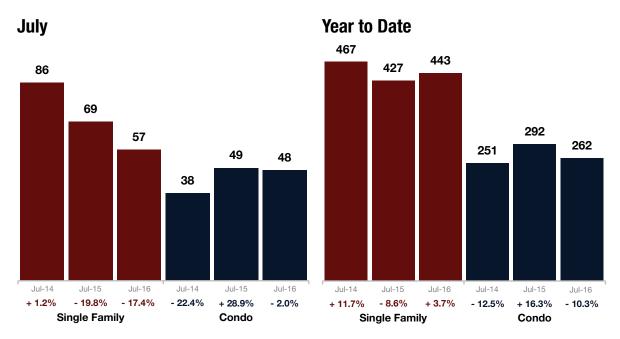

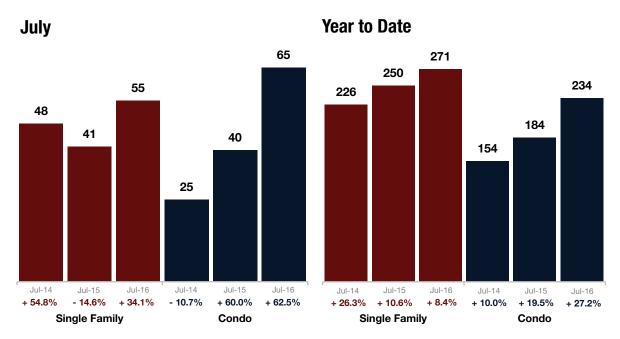

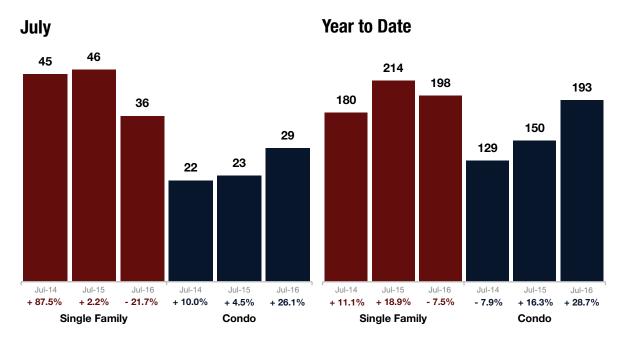

### **Historical Pending Sales by Month**



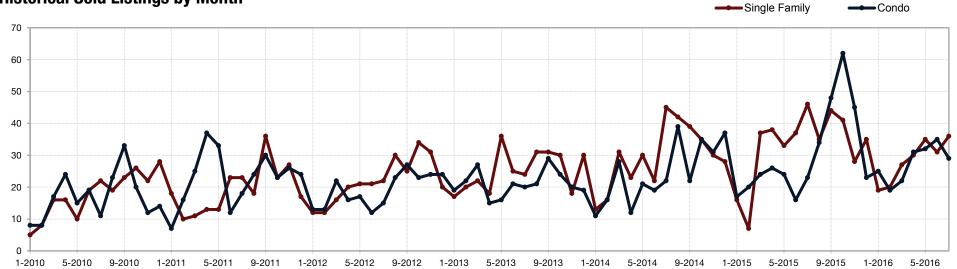

### **Historical Median Sales Price by Month**



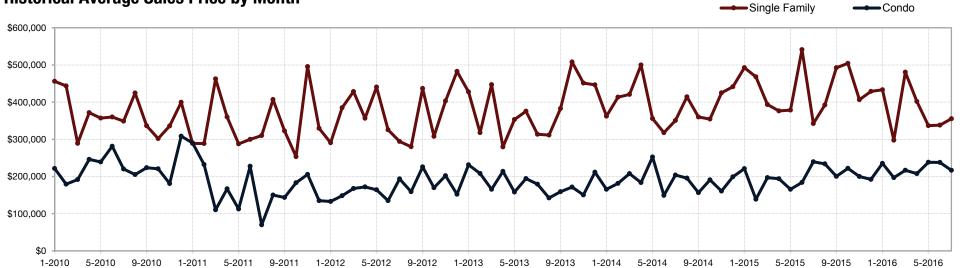

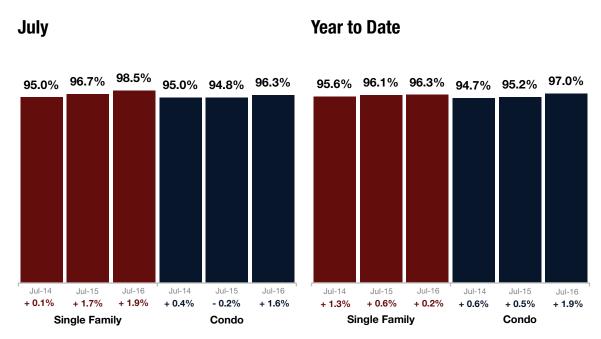

#### **Historical Average Sales Price by Month**



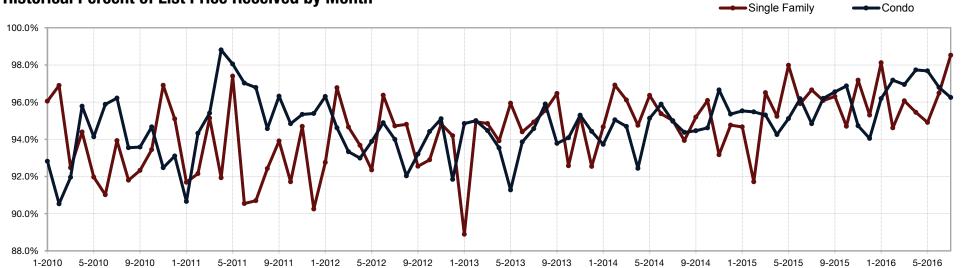

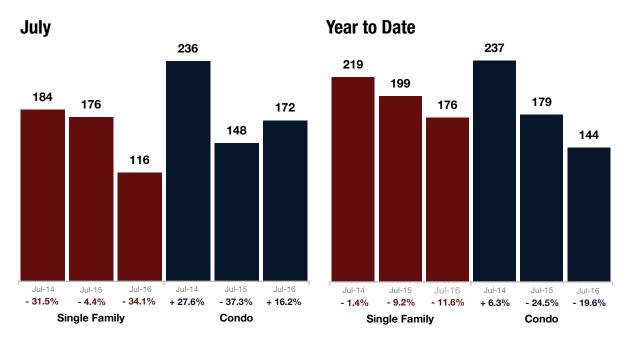

#### **Historical Percent of List Price Received by Month**



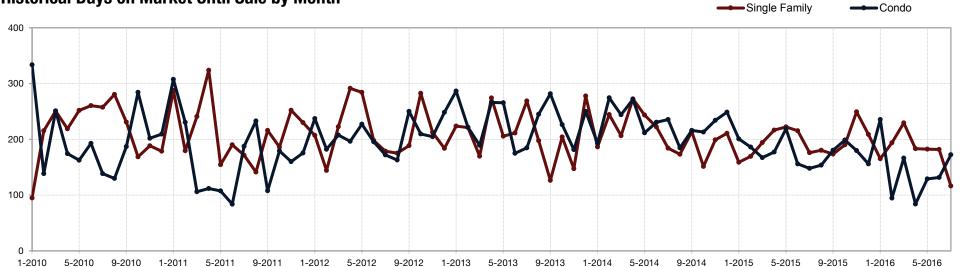

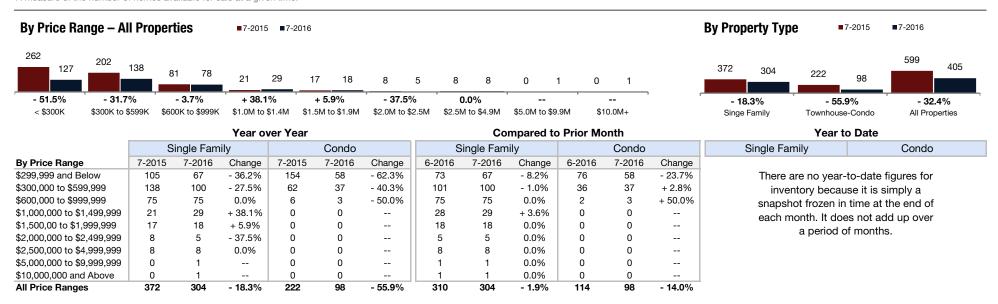

A measure of the number of homes available for sale at a given time.



# **Glossary of Terms**

A research tool provided by the Colorado Association of REALTORS®



New Listings	A measure of how much new supply is coming onto the market from sellers.	
Pending Sales	A count of all the listings that went into Pending status during the reported period. Pending listings are counted at the end of the reported period. Each listing can only be counted one time. If a listing goes into Pending, out of Pending, then back into Pending all in one reported period, this listing would only be counted once. This is the most real-time measure possible for home buyer activity, as it measures signed contracts on sales rather than the actual closed sale. As such, it is called a "leading indicator" of buyer demand.	
Sold Listings	A measure of home sales that were closed to completion during the report period.	
Median Sales Price	A measure of home values in a market area where 50% of activity was higher and 50% was lower than this price point.	
Average Sales Price	A sum of all home sales prices divided by total number of sales.	
Percent of List Price Received	A mathematical calculation of the percent difference from last list price and sold price for those listings sold in the reported period.	
Days on Market Until Sale	A measure of how long it takes homes to sell, on average.	
Housing Affordability Index	A measure of how affordable a region's housing is to its consumers. A higher number means greater affordability. The index is based on interest rates, median sales price and average income by county.	
Inventory of Active Listings	A measure of the number of homes available for sale at a given time. The availability of homes for sale has a big effect on supply-demand dynamics and home prices.	
Months Supply of Inventory	A measure of how balanced the market is between buyers and sellers. It is expressed as the number of months it would hypothetically take to sell through all the available homes for sale, given current levels of home sales. A balanced market ranges from 4 to 7 months of supply. A buyer's market has a higher number, reflecting fewer buyers relative to homes for sale. A seller's market has a lower number, reflecting more buyers relative to homes for sale.
