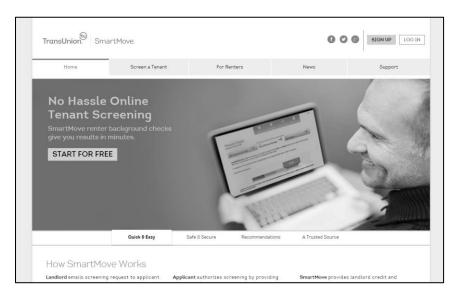
Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide TransUnion SmartMove Renter's a guide to show the process of creating their renter account, accepting a request and sending their consumer reports to a potential landlord.

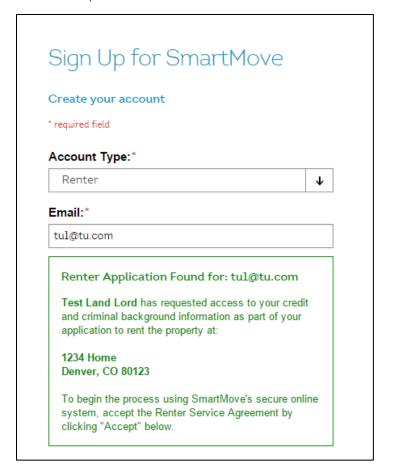
Creating an Account

A renter will create their renter account once a landlord has sent the renter a request to create an account via email. To reply to the request the renter must create a SmartMove Renter account, approve the application, and successfully complete identity authentication for the renter's consumer report(s) to be sent to the landlord.

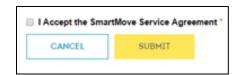
1. To create an account click **Sign Up**.



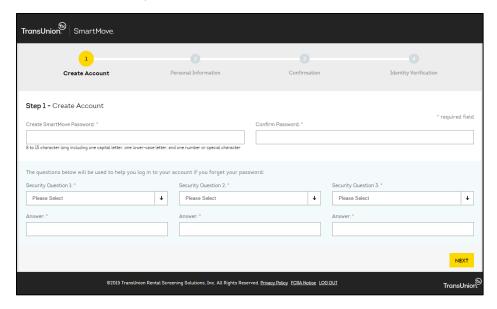
2. The first page will ask for an email address to create the renter account. It is important that the email address entered matches the email address that the landlord used to send the initial request. If a different email address is used, the pending request will not appear and the landlord will not receive the consumer report(s).



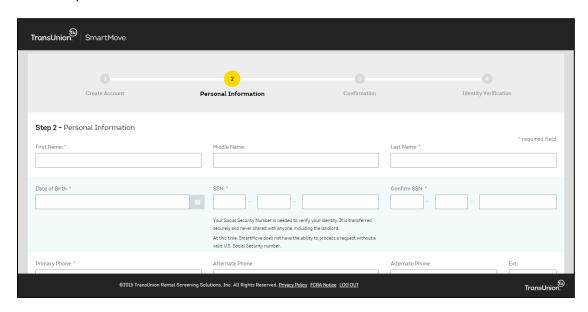
- 3. When a landlord has already sent an application request to the email address, SmartMove informs the renter of the landlord's name and property address.
- 4. Carefully read the Service Agreement and click I Accept the SmartMove Service Agreement and Save to continue.



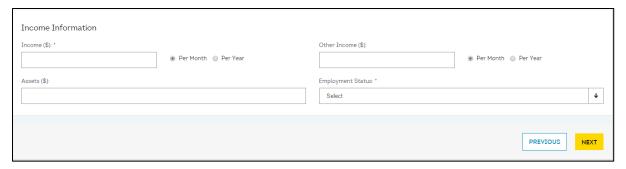
5. Next, a renter will create a password and select three security questions to answer. If any requirements are not met, red help text will appear.



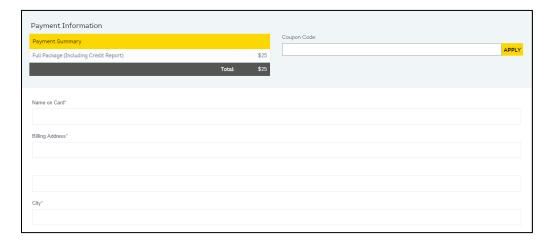
- 6. Once the security questions have been set-up, personal information is required to be entered by the renter. It is important that this information is entered accurately, because the personal information will be used to retrieve identity authentication questions as well as the consumer report(s).
 - a. A valid U.S. Social Security number is required to proceed with the account creation. A primary phone number and current address are also required.



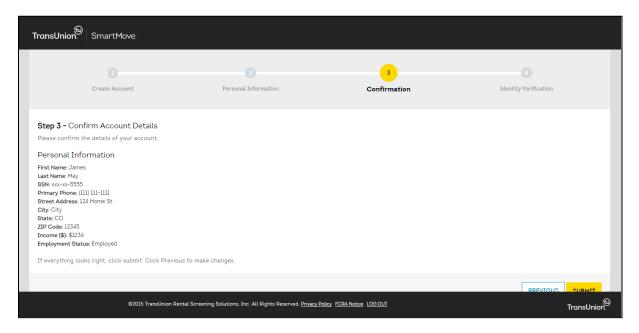
7. Next, income information must be provided. Income can be entered on a Per Month or Per Year basis. There is also an option to enter Other Income and/or Assets. Employment status is also required.



8. If the landlord selected the option for the renter to pay for the SmartMove application, enter credit card information here. When applicable enter a coupon code and click **Apply**.



9. Once the required personal information has been entered, a pop-up window will ask to **Confirm and go to the Next Step**.

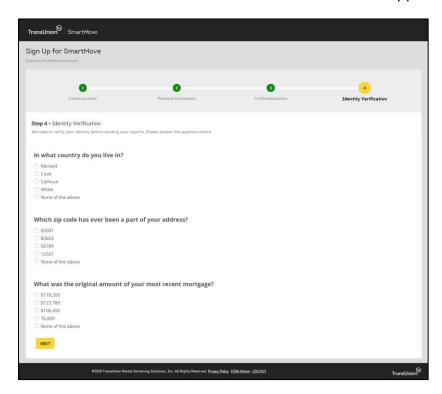


10. Identity authentication must be completed. Multiple authentication questions are generated that are related to the renter's identity and credit history. Once the



questions have been answered correctly, a pop-up window will appear to confirm that identity authentication has been completed. At this time the reports will be sent to the landlord.

a. If the renter does not answer the identity authentication questions correctly or is not presented with an identity authentication exam, the renter will be instructed to contact TransUnion SmartMove Customer Support.

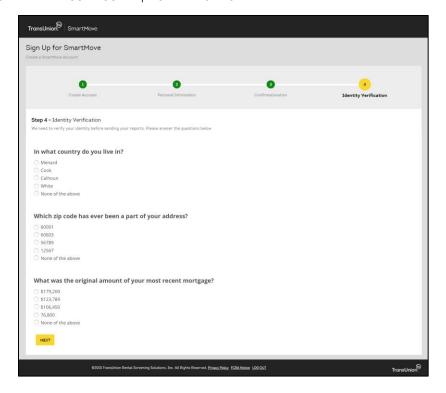


Authentication

Types of Questions

The potential renter ("renter") will be presented with three (3) to four (4) questions. SmartMove asks questions that may be derived from the consumer's credit report and/or demographic information. These questions will vary by renter depending on the amount of information available regarding the particular consumer. The following are some examples of questions TransUnion SmartMove may ask:

- In what country do you live in?
- Which zip code has ever been part of your address?



Attempts

The renter will be required to answer all questions correctly in order to pass authentication. If the renter does not answer all questions correctly within the first attempt, they will be given "second" chance questions. The "second" chance questions are part of the first set of questions; for example, if the renter is required to answer four (4) of four (4) questions correctly and the renter answers three (3) of four (4) correctly, the "second" chance attempt may ask only one (1) additional question. If the renter does not successfully answer the "second" chance question(s), the renter will be presented with six (6) more online exams. The "second" chance questions do not count against the renter as an online attempt.



After each online attempt, the renter is given the option to contact Customer Support or make an additional online attempt.

Try Again

If the renter cannot successfully pass authentication after seven (7) online attempts they will be prompted to contact Customer Support for further assistance.

Unfortunately, you have reached the maximum allowable attempts to verify your identity online. To complete your application and send your reports to the landlord, please call customer support to be verified over the phone at 1-866-775-0961.

Contacting Customer Support

If a renter is prompted to contact Customer Support after unsuccessfully completing the online exams, they are given two (2) chances to pass authentication verbally via the telephone with Customer Support. The renter should prepare for the verbal authentication attempt by having ready:

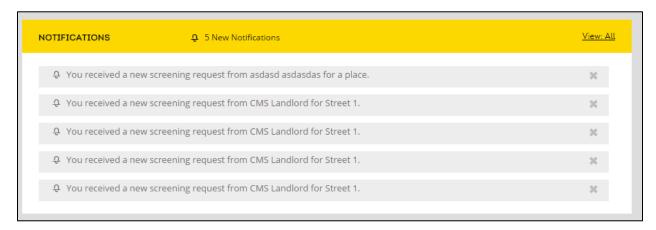
- A copy of their current credit report from <u>www.annualcreditreport.com</u>
- Credit card statement(s)
- Car payment information
- A copy of their driver's license
- Other similar identifying or financial documentation(s)

The verbal attempts will be the renter's last opportunity to pass authentication.

Once authentication is passed online or through the alternative phone-in process, the renter's reports are released to the landlord.

Additional Features

The renter dashboard shows notifications and active applications. The notifications section will display a history of applications and account changes. Individual notifications can be removed by clicking the **X**.



The **Active Applications** section shows the status of any current applications and new application requests from other potential landlords.
