By following the advice contained below we aim to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in our Church and community.

Responsibilities

While Mt Zion endeavors to reduce the risk of infection it reminds all of those who are involved in the provision and use of its facilities and programs that they have a responsibility to do likewise by following the guidelines and recommendations of the CDC and the Department of Health. Participation in all programs and use of our facilities are “at your own risk”. Your voluntary participation in our programs, such as VBS, and use of our facilities will release Mt Zion of all liability.

Advice and Guidelines

To ensure that all who attend the programs and use the facilities of Mt Zion Baptist have the most accurate information in relation to what they should do to ensure best practice, everyone is advised to read the advice provided by the CDC, Department of Health and on their respective websites: •
