A resource for parents and children to help everyone cope with cancer.

This support group provides resources to assist families when an adult family member is diagnosed with cancer. We believe that children and teens benefit from a safe environment where they can express their feelings through art, play, and being with others who are in a similar situation.

Some meetings bring families together as a whole, while others divide groups by age, with a parent group meeting at the same time. All groups are facilitated by trained professionals and are offered free of charge, no matter where your cancer care is received.
