Does my membership change?

This change in management will not affect your membership. Your membership at the fitness center will remain the same, and you do not need to take any actions during this transition.

Will the training and/or class packages that I've paid for be honored once management is transitioned to Active Wellness?

Will there be any changes to classes that are being offered?
