83704	Lipoprotein, blood; quantitation of lipoprotein particle numbers and lipoprotein particle subclasses, when performed
83718	Lipoprotein, direct measurement; high density cholesterol (HDL cholesterol)
83721	Lipoprotein, direct measurement, LDL cholesterol
