UPDATE: As of Wednesday, October 25<sup>th</sup>, we have 3 residents who have tested positive for Covid. All are in one lodge and are on isolation. Universal masking has been implemented in all 4 lodges; N-95 masks are required in the affected lodge.

#### VISITATION:

Visitation remains open. We ask that you don a mask prior to entering. If you are visiting a someone in a lodge with positive Covid cases, PSMH asks that you take extra precautions. This includes wearing an N95 mask, remember to socially distance and keep your visit brief. Please be sure to sign in before entering. Children are welcome but are asked to follow the same rule as adults.
