INSURANCE OPTIONS

Check Your Insurance Benefits

Transportation assistance may be available through your health insurance plan.

Medicaid/Oregon Health Plan (OHP)

If you have Medicaid/OHP coverage, transportation assistance and mileage reimbursement may be available for eligible medical appointments.

Ride to Care Services

For eligible Medicaid Health Share or OHP members.

Schedule rides at least 48 hours before your appointment.

Medicare Advantage Plans

Some Medicare Advantage plans offer Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) benefits.

Transportation services and benefits vary by county. Call the Member Services number on the back of your insurance card to learn about available transportation benefits.
