Check Your Insurance Benefits

Transportation assistance may be available through your health insurance plan.

Medicaid/Oregon Health Plan (OHP)

Transportation assistance and mileage reimbursement may be available for eligible medical appointments.

For mileage reimbursement benefit, contact your Medicaid case manager.
