

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN COVENANT SCHOOL OF RADIOGRAPHY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF PROVIDENCE

OVERVIEW:

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by Covenant School of Radiography, hereinafter referred to as CSOR, and the University of Providence, hereinafter referred to as UP. By this agreement CSOR and UP express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to and success in higher education.

PURPOSE:

This agreement provides students who have completed radiologic science work at CSOR with coursework in Radiography the opportunity to complete an Associate of Science (and/or Bachelor of Science) in **Healthcare Administration** degree at UP.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

Criteria for acceptance into UP will be the same for transfer as for native students.

UP will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to CSOR transfer students as those applicable to native students at UP.

Section II: Transfer of Credit

An equivalent of 45 semester credits (maximum) will be accepted by UP from CSOR to be applied to the Associate of Science (and/or Bachelor of Science) in Healthcare Administration degree as outlined in this agreement.

Section III: Program Plan

This agreement indicates that the program requirements and outcomes at CSOR meet equivalent requirements for credit acceptance by UP. Students falling under this program articulation agreement will be responsible for successfully completing the additional prescribed requirements to complete the University Core curriculum at UP.

TERMS of AGREEMENT:

This agreement is made and entered into in the academic year 2021-2022 and remains in effect unless changed in writing by mutual agreement to both parties. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to annual review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either party desire to discontinue this agreement, advance notification of one year will be required.



- University of Providence requires (for Associate Degrees):
 - Complete a minimum of 60 credits.
 - Maintain a cumulative University of Providence grade point average of 2.00 or higher.
 - Complete the associate degree Core Curriculum.
 - Complete an area of specialization. All courses used to complete the specialization must have a grade of "C" or better.
 - Complete at least twenty of the final thirty semester hours of coursework at the University of Providence.
 - Complete a minimum of 40% or 15 credits of their major (whichever is greater) in residency at the University of Providence.
 - Apply for graduation in accordance with the prescribed deadlines.
 - Comply with all University policies, rules, and regulations.
 - Pay all indebtedness to the University.
- In addition to the above, University of Providence requires (for Baccalaureate Degrees):
 - Complete a minimum of 120 credits.
 - Complete the bachelor degree Core Curriculum.
 - Complete at least thirty of the final forty semester hours of coursework at the University of Providence.
