Successful Completion of the Program

Upon successful completion of the program’s performance requirements, the student will be certified at the following levels: Open Water Diver, Advanced Open Water Diver, Rescue Diver, Emergency First Response Primary & Secondary Care Provider, PADI Divemaster, PADI Assistant Instructor, PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor, PADI Specialty Instructor, and Emergency First Response Instructor. The student will receive the certification from PADI. The certifications will be processed upon completion of each individual course and not at the end of the program. With the exception of the PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor course certification, that does involve a third-party examination of the student. That third-party examination is known as the “PADI Instructor Exam” and is conducted independently by PADI and is included as part of the fee structure and course calendar. Students will also receive instruction in dive center operation and dive boat management. The student will receive a Diploma in Scuba Diving Industry and Operations Management.

Terms of Payment

The enrollment application fee is \$75. The tuition, eLearning, and equipment fees are due in full on the first day of the program. Payments may be made in cash, by credit card, or bank transfer. The PADI certification fees are due at the beginning of the related course. Entrance fees which are paid directly to the facilities are due on/or before the date the facility is used. Equipment rental fees are applied to all courses with an in-water component, with the exception of the Open Water Diver course. Equipment rental fees may be waived if the student chooses to invest in their own equipment of which package pricing is available.

These are the courses that have certification fees and the week in which those fees would be due:

Divemaster (Week 11); Emergency First Response Instructor (Week 12); Instructor Development Course (Week 17); Specialty Instructor (Week 19); and Tec Rec Gas Blender Instructor (Week 20).

Lake Allure has a fee structure that allows for daily, monthly, and seasonal access. For the program, the 3-month entrance pass is the most economical. It is to be paid directly to those operating the lake at their website www.divepeer.com prior to initial use which would be in Week 2. This entrance fee will apply to the open water activities of the diving courses.

For students receiving VA Benefits, note that the application fee and entrance fees paid to other entities are not certifiable by the Veterans Administration.

Cancellation Policy

The enrollment fee is fully refundable if the student request cancellation within 5 calendar days after signing the enrollment agreement. agreement or if the alternative set forth in PA § 73.121 (relating to general requirement) is used, 5 calendar days after submitting the application, if no classes have been attended, lessons completed, or materials used. A request for cancellation which is not made in writing shall be confirmed in writing by the student within an additional period of 5 calendar days. The school may retain all the fee after 5 calendar days or after 10 calendar days absent written confirmation, where required.

Refund Policy

If an applicant is rejected by Blue Crew Divers, that person is entitled to a refund of monies paid. Refunds are made automatically if medical clearance cannot be secured. Students will receive refunds for unused books and required materials still in the original packaging, as well as any eLearning which has not been redeemed or started.

If a student enrolls and withdraws or discontinues after the program has begun, but prior to the completion of the term the following minimum refunds apply: 1) For a student withdrawing from or discontinuing the program during the first 7 calendar days of the program, the tuition charges refunded by the school shall be at least 75% of the tuition for the term. 2) For a student withdrawing from or discontinuing the program after the first 7 calendar days, but within the first 25% of the program, the tuition charges refunded by Blue Crew Divers shall be at least 55% of the tuition for the program. 3) For a student withdrawing or discontinuing after 50% of the program, the student is not entitled to a refund. The percentage of the program shall be determined by comparing the number of completed lessons received for services by the school to the total number of lessons in the program.

The termination date for refund computation purposes is the last date of recorded attendance of the student or the date the student requests cancellation.

PADI Application fees are only charged by PADI upon completion of a course and acceptance by PADI of certification. Any course for which an application fee has been paid there would be no refund. For courses that have not been completed no application fee would be charged.

Any refund for non-use or partial use of the facility at Lake Allure would be at the discretion of those who manage the facility.

Refunds shall be made within 30 calendar days of the date the student fails to enter, leaves the program, or fails to return from a leave of absence.

Any eLearning codes that have been redeemed by the student from PADI are not eligible for refund. Unredeemed eLearning codes for students who withdraw from the program are eligible for a pro-ration of the fees based on the same time and percentage as the tuition refund procedures. Any gear purchased is not eligible for a refund.

Complaint Procedures

In the event there is a complaint or a concern, then the student is directed to contact Dr. Everette W Ingram, Jr., the School Director regarding satisfying the terms of the enrollment agreement. Blue Crew Divers is registered by the Pennsylvania State Board of Private Licensed Schools. Questions or concerns that are not satisfactorily resolved by the school may be brought to the attention of the Pennsylvania State Board of Private Licensed Schools, Division of Postsecondary Proprietary Training, Pennsylvania Department of Education, 607 South Drive; Floor 3E; Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Equipment Requirements

Diving is an equipment reliant sport. There are two categories that apply: personal and life support. Personal scuba diving equipment includes a mask, snorkel, fins, and boots. The life support equipment includes BCD (Buoyancy Control Device), regulator, dive computer, instrumentation, exposure protection, cylinders, and weight system. These are required for all students and required to be purchased through Blue Crew Divers.

Blue Crew Divers has developed a specific package for this diploma program, which includes all necessary personal, life support, and accessory gear the candidate will need throughout the duration of this program.

With the investment in life support equipment air fills will be provided at no additional cost.

Transportation Requirements

As much of the educational requirements will be conducted off site at either a pool or open water environment, the student handles their own transportation to and from those locations.

Technology Requirements

The educational components of the courses will be delivered through eLearning and live. The student must have access to a device that allows internet connectivity. Those students who are receiving VA benefits must complete all sessions in person, as distance learning is not certifiable by the Veterans Administration.

Medical Requirements

Each student will need to complete a Medical Questionnaire prior to any in-water activity. Should the student have a YES on that questionnaire, they will need to obtain a physician's approval that declares them as fit for diving. The cost of any medical consultation is borne by the student.

Employment Assistance

Blue Crew Divers will provide job placement assistance. We cannot guarantee employment.

Attendance Policy

I agree to abide by the attendance requirements as outlined in the Blue Crew Divers catalog. I understand that tardiness and early departures may result in being given an unexcused absence. I have been informed of the attendance policy as it relates to excused and unexcused absences. I understand that administrative action, as outlined in the catalog, may be enacted that places me in a probationary period should there be violations of the attendance policy.
