

PADI Divemaster Course

Program Overview

The Aquarius Dive Shop PADI Divemaster Course is comprised of two parts: Part One is developing skills and knowledge to become a PADI Divemaster; and Part Two is an apprenticeship in which you will help with in-water activities with classes and with experienced divers. When you sign up with us, we will provide a general overview of the Divemaster Course, including the time commitments and some of the key activities that you get to do.

Prerequisites:

- Certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver and PADI Rescue Diver
- 18 years old
- Logged 40 scuba dives
- Current EFR Primary and Secondary Care training or qualifying training
- Be fit for diving and submit a Diver Medical signed by an authorized medical professional within 12 months

Core Performance requirements:

- Complete the Divermaster eLearning, and pass the Divermaster Final Exam
- Create an Emergency Assistance Plan for a designated dive site
- Complete the Waterskills Exercises
- Complete a Diver Rescue Assessment
- Complete the Dive Skills Workshop
- Complete Practical Applications
 - Practical Skills
 - Divemaster-Conducted Programs Workshops
 - Practical Assessments
- Meet the Professionalism criteria
- At time of certification: logged at least 60 scuba dives including experience in night diving, deep diving and underwater navigation.
- EFR Primary and Secondary Care training current within 24 months.
- Read and agreed to the PADI Membership and License Agreements.

- Complete Dive Theory eLearning
- Complete Equipment Specialty Course
- Complete Search & Recovery Specialty Course
- Complete Deep Diver Specialty Course
