Leaks

For leaks, seek assistance from a certified regulator technician and be prepared to show him/her where the leak(s) are occurring.

Wash your Regulator

Wash your regulator in warm, fresh water: If you don't have a tank to pressurize the system, don't press the purge, as this will let water into hoses and the first stage; especially, wash around the hose swivels. Flush through the mouthpiece and out the exhaust tee.

Air Dry

Don't hang your reg by its hoses, as this puts stress on them. Lay your reg in the shade until it's dry, then pack it away with hoses loosely coiled. Again, don't stress the hoses by coiling them too tightly
