

Join Streamline Diving aboard the Atlantis Azores liveaboard (Part 1) for an amazing 7 Nights adventure to the beautiful dive sites in Tubbataha! Cruise with us through the epicenter of marine diversity! Tubbataha is located in the Sulu Sea at the center of the Coral Triangle. It is a UNESCO world heritage site and a marine preserve. Tubbataha is made up of two reefs which enclose a sandy lagoon frequented by nesting turtles. At Tubbataha, vertical walls and dramatic drop offs provide for the Philippines best big fish diving! You can expect to see large Napoleon Wrasse, Bumphead Parrotfish, Massive schools of fish, White tip and Grey reef sharks and the occasional Manta, Hammerhead, Tiger or Whale Shark! That is just the tip of the iceberg! There are so many species to see from pygmy seahorses, numerous species of nudibranchs, turtles, and some of the most pristine corals in the world! Embarkation is on the 23rd of May. Included is concierge round-trip flight between Manila and Puerto Princesa and one night (May 22nd) in hotel pre-trip (in either Manila or Puerto Princesa – to be determined).



Point of embarkation and disembarkation Puerto Princesa

* Atlantis concierge round-trip transfers between Manila and Puerto Princesa (Value US\$390.00 per person) Includes roundtrip domestic economy airfare between Manila and Puerto Princesa, 1 bag of 30 Kg/66 lbs of checked luggage, round trip air-conditioned van between the international terminal and domestic terminals in Manila when applicable, round-trip transfers between Puerto Princesa airport and Azores, personal airport meet and greet, and luggage assistance. Since we STRONGLY recommend everyone arrive in Manila at least a day prior to the trip, we have also included one night in hotel pre-trip (Manila or Puerto Princesa), personal meet and greet for international flight as well as domestic and transfers between the airport and the transit hotel wherever needed depending on flight arrivals. We will either arrive in Manila early in the day and depart that same day for the Puerto Princesa where you can rest for a night prior to getting picked up at the host hotel to go to the Azores. Or, we will overnight in Manila and depart early morning for Puerto Princesa. Regardless of which option we will be guided every step of the way. The airport experience in Manila can be daunting – Atlantis and Streamline will make it less daunting.

Important Note: Due to continuity and scheduling issues, all portions of domestic transfers for Azores bookings must be made by Atlantis. We highly recommend guests arrive in the Philippines a day before their Azores charter departure date. We can assist with local hotel reservations in Manila or Puerto Princesa. In cases where guests miss flights, the ship will not wait for them and will depart on schedule.

Price for this vacation is US\$4,950 pp including taxes. Deluxe Cabin Double Occupancy
Deluxe Cabin Single upgrade is 70% of the double occupancy rate.

**Marine Park Fees are mandated by local municipalities and may change at any time. Guests are responsible for paying marine park fees at the time of their stay on their bill.

***Rental equipment is available at our resorts in Puerto Galera (Apo Reef/Coro charters) and Dumaguete (Visayas charters) but not for Tubbataha charters. For details and options, please contact Reservations.

****Medical and dive accident insurance is mandatory for all liveaboard charters and recommended for resort diving We highly recommend each guest purchase trip cancellation and interruption insurance. Weather conditions, health problems and many other unforeseen reasons can change travel plans and/or cause financial losses that should be covered by insurance. Cancellations, losses, and disruptions caused by reasons outside of Atlantis' responsibility will be shouldered by the guests unless they are insured.

Tubbataha diving is typically deep (24m/80ft to 30m/100ft) multi-level wall dives and moderate to strong currents are not unusual.

The Tubbataha Protected Area Management Board has banned single-use plastic items in the area.
PLEASE DO NOT BRING SINGLE-USE PLASTIC ITEMS.

Drones require a permit for use in Tubbataha, please let me know if you need a permit request form. No permit = no drone use.

Cash is required for drinks and souvenirs at the ranger station if you wish to purchase
