Diving



Roatan has the world's second-largest barrier reef, with over 35 incredible dive sites just a 5-20 minute boat ride from the dive shop – all within a protected marine park! Expect crystal-clear water (think 50-100ft visibility) and balmy 80-degree temperatures year-round, making every dive epic.

Diving from West End, Roatan offers a taste of the island's underwater wonders. Expect sheer walls teeming with life at West End Wall, where currents can bring in pelagic fish like barracuda and eagle rays.

For something different, explore the unique Hole in the Wall, a swim-through with canyons and caverns perfect for testing your buoyancy skills (advanced certification recommended).

Beginners will find gentler currents and colorful reefs at sites like Blue Channel. Wrecks are also on the menu, with the broken remains of El Aguila (advanced divers only) offering a haven for marine life.

No matter your experience level, there's a captivating dive site waiting to be explored just a short boat ride from the resort.



Marine Life



Roatan's vibrant reefs boast a dazzling array of marine life, from the colorful cast of characters like angelfish, butterflyfish, and parrotfish flitting through the coral, to the majestic eagle rays gliding effortlessly by.



You might also spot graceful sea turtles munching on seagrass meadows, or even get a glimpse of sharks (mostly nurse sharks and reef sharks) cruising the deeper areas.

If you're lucky, you might encounter playful dolphins or pods of them weaving through the blue. Keep your eyes peeled for the smaller wonders too, like vibrant nudibranchs and fascinating seahorses camouflaged amongst the coral.

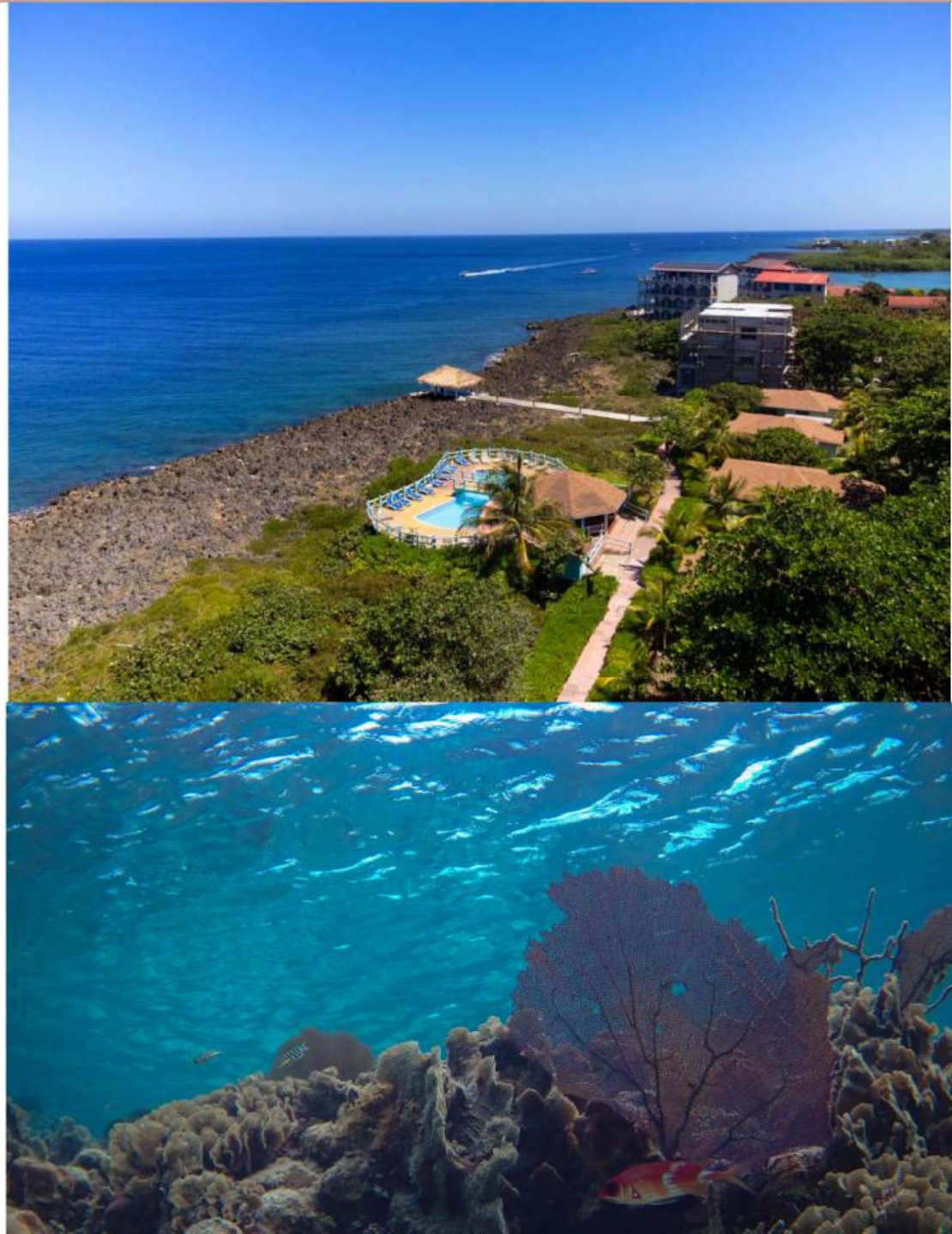

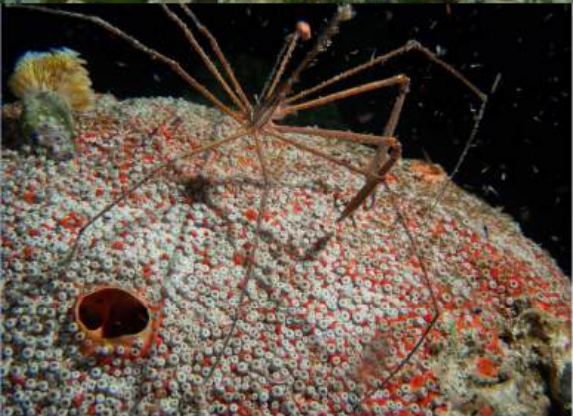
