- ❖ Learn how to **build artificial reef structures** and place them underwater in strategic formations
- ❖ Collect, propagate, and **outplant nursery-grown corals** onto artificial reef structures
- ❖ Monitor various facets of **reef data**, including coral health and growth, water quality measurements, and fish count
- ❖ Discover a **community** of like-minded people who share a passion for coral restoration
- ❖ Explore all that **beautiful Bocas del Toro** has to offer, from breathtaking beaches, excellent surfing and sailing, cacao farms, and a variety of tours

### Program Location

Located on the main island of Isla Colon in Bocas del Toro, Panama. Bocas del Toro was declared a Hope Spot in December 2019 by Sylvia Earle's Mission Blue. It is home to countless important marine organisms including sharks, sea turtles, bottlenose dolphins, over 120 species of sponge, three different species of mangroves and a diverse array of Caribbean coral species.
