### **Aquarium Dive Agreement and Responsibilities**

Thank you for joining Atlantic Edge Scuba for a dive at the Aquarium. The below items will help you understand some requirements require to participate in the dive. We ask that you read this form, initial where indicated, and sign at the bottom.

DIVER RESPONSIBILITIES (please initial)
Must provide a proof of certification at least equivalent to Open Water level. Must be 18 years old. (PADI Scuba Diver Certification does not qualify as certification). If it's been a while since your last dive, we highly recommend a refresher course prior to your dive. The aquarium is a confined space and proper buoyancy control is a required skill to make the dive. (If your certification cared does not have a picture or name has change, must provide a government issued phot ID)
Diver is responsible for completing all required documents prior to their scheduled dive date. Forms include medical, liability waiver, safe diving statement and jelly fish disclosure document. Medical forms may require a physician's approval; PLEASE COMPLETE IMMEDIATELY. Physicians' medical clearance documents can be found our website.
Diver will need to provide proof covid vaccination prior to their scheduled dive.
Diver is responsible for providing bathing suit, towel, full wetsuit, mask, fins, and booties or socks. If you do not hav this equipment, you can rent it from Atlantic Edge Scuba.
GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (please initial)
Documents needed as listed above must be received 5 days prior to the scheduled dive or diver may not be permitted to dive. No refund will be issued if diver is unable to dive.
Only the BCD, regulator, tanks, and weights provided by the Aquarium are permitted to be used. No need to bring all that heavy equipment with you. The Aquarium does also provide gloves if you don't own any.
If you have friends and family who would like to watch you dive, they will need to purchase regular tickets to the Aquarium. We suggest buying tickets in advance on their website: <a href="www.aqua.org">www.aqua.org</a> .
Any jewelry needs to be removed prior to the dive or must be covered. No signs, banners or slates allowed during you dive. No cameras are allowed in the Aquarium exhibit (mask with cameras build in, lenses will be covered).
I hereby grant Atlantic Edge Scuba and the National Aquarium the irrevocable right and permission to use photograph and/or video recordings on Atlantic Edge's website, publications, promotional flyers, in our newsletters, or for any other similar purpose without compensation to me. I understand and agree that such photographs and/or video recordings of me may be placed on the internet.
CANCELLATION/RESCHEDULE POLICY (please initial)
If you need to cancel or reschedule for any reason the spot must be filled by another person. You can opt to have us look for another person to take your spot for a fee of \$50, or you can find that person. No refund of any kind can be issued if the spot remains empty. If you decide to cancel or reschedule only a few days before your dives it will be very difficult to find a replacement so you can recover your fees. Atlantic Edge must be notified of any name changes by email no later than the Thursday at 4pm before the dives are scheduled to take place.
Divers who do not attend the dive without making other arrangements beforehand will be subject to a 100% cancellation/reschedule fee.
In the event the dive is canceled due to circumstances outside of Atlantic Edge Scuba's control (weather, animal behavior, exhibit/facility issues, etc.) diver would have the opportunity to reschedule into another date of their choosing.

- 1. I am aware that diving has inherent risks and dangers, known and unknown, which may result in serious injury or death. Specifically, I understand that scuba diving with compressed air involves risks including but not limited to decompression sickness, embolism or other hyperbaric/air expansion injury that may require treatment in a recompression chamber. I understand that the National Aquarium does not have a recompression chamber, and that access to a recompression chamber will require time and travel. I still choose to proceed with the dive program in spite of the absence of a recompression chamber in proximity to the dive site. I understand that diving is a physically strenuous activity and that I will be exerting myself during this program, and that I may suffer heart attack, panic, hyperventilation, and/or drowning. I understand that diving in aquarium exhibits will put me in the presence of hazardous marine life and challenging environmental conditions.
- 2. I hereby state that I am a competent, certified diver, with knowledge of the risks and dangers of diving. In consideration of being allowed to participate in the diving program, I hereby personally assume any and all risk of personal injury (including death) and property damage which may occur during (and/or as a result of) the above referenced activities at the Aquarium.
- 3. I hereby release, acquit, exonerate, and forever discharge National Aquarium and their affiliates, directors, officers, agents, volunteers, and employees (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for personal injury (including death) and/or property damage which may occur during (and/or as result of) the above referenced activities at the Aquarium.

### National Aquarium (NA) ACR Box Jellyfish Diving Disclosure Agreement

### I. Background

On March 18, 2020, an unidentified box jellyfish (*Alatinidae* species) was found in the Atlantic Coral Reef (ACR) exhibit. We reached out to experts in treatment protocol for jellyfish stings at Divers Alert Network (DAN) and in Australia and were advised that the <u>individual</u> species of juvenile medusae we found (not easily visible to the human eye and only a few mm in size) would not have the venom components to cause any full-blown Irukandji syndrome (see description below). It was also relayed that the chances of the species we discovered envenomating would be incredibly remote. The National Aquarium has long history of safe diving in the exhibit (staff, volunteers, and guest immersion divers) for over 34 years.

<u>Irukandji syndrome</u>: The exact mechanism of action of the venom is unknown. When properly treated, a single sting is almost never fatal. Symptoms include headache, backache, chest and abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, pathological sweating, severe and sudden onset anxiety, tachycardia. Usual onset: 30 minutes after exposure. Duration: 4 – 30 hours; sometimes up to 2 weeks.

### II. NA Statement

While the Diving Safety Office does not feel there is any reason for divers to be worried about envenomation exposure, it is mandatory that all divers be informed of the possible effects associated with Irukandji syndrome. It is also necessary for divers to understand that they may decline to dive in the Atlantic Coral Reef exhibit with no fear of repercussion to their involvement in the volunteer program at the National Aquarium. An Atlantic Edge Guest Immersion Diver who declines to dive, will not be booked nor charged for this Immersion experience at the National Aquarium.

### III. Safety Precautions in Place

On site, at NA, we have the following response and safety protocols in place in the unlikely event of an envenomation:

- First Aid Response document outlining treatment for an envenomation including our Shock Trauma Hospital hyperbaric physician, Douglas Sward, contact information. The document will be sent with an injured diver to Shock Trauma Center in the case of an envenomation.
- NA Dive Locker Jelly envenomation response kit. This is inclusive of Divers Alert Network Marine Life injuries slates, a spray bottle of vinegar, plastic scrapers, and tweezers for mechanical removal. Gloves are also available.
- Dive Safety Officers are trained as Hazardous Marine Life Injury Instructors.
- All Guest Immersion Dive Supervisors are trained in DAN First Aid for Professional Divers including hazardous marine life injuries.

The National Aquarium is requesting your signature acknowledging that you have been informed of the possible effects of envenomation and that with that awareness you choose to freely participate in ongoing diving operations in the Atlantic Coral Reef exhibit.
