## **Lodging:**

**Group Lodging/AirBnB:** Located 21 miles from the Quarry, we have reserved a spacious 5 bedroom/3 bathroom home for group accommodations. Available on a first come, first serve basis. Breakfast included. **\$270 pp** for your own private room, **\$140 pp** (double occupancy) for divers booking together and sharing a bed.

There are also a few hotels close in proximity to each other in Hopkinsville, KY. You are free to chose your own hotel.

## **Trip Fee Schedule:**

*Divers in training:* \$375 includes: 2 days gear rental (not including wetsuit), 2 days diving fees, air fills, four dives under PADI Instructor supervision, and PADI Certification, drinking water, light snacks. Students with their own full gear: \$325.

*Certified divers needing gear rental:* \$300 includes: 2 days gear rental (not including wetsuit), 2 days diving fees, air fills, and dives under PADI Divemaster direct or indirect supervision, drinking water, light snacks.

*Certified divers with their own gear:* \$250 includes: 2 days diving fees, air fills, dives under PADI Divemaster direct or indirect supervision, drinking water, light snacks.

Friday, August 28, 2026

5:00 PM Trip fees and your rental gear reservation are due. Use this link to complete your online registration with Pennyroyal (look for the new student roster box on the bottom right hand of any of the webpages). If you have traveled to Pennyroyal before and have your Pennyroyal ID Card, you do not have to register again. You will have to sign in at the drive thru booth and get an arm band only. Saturday, September 12, 2026

8:15 AM Staff arrives at quarry for sign in and set up, only Instructors and Shop owners are allowed in at this time

8:45 AM	Please depart your area lodging and go directly to the quarry.
9:00 AM	Arrive at quarry, stop at booth to get armband, drive down to our pavilion at the water's edge, then bring your car back up to one of the designated parking areas. Return to pavilion, set up gear and wait for briefing.
9:30 AM	Dive Site briefing
10:00 AM	Dive #1
Noon	Dive #2
1:00 PM	Lunch break, dive stories, logbook signing
2:30 PM	Dive Briefing for afternoon dive
4:00 PM	Pack up and head for lodging
6:30 PM	Join the group for a dinner at a local area restaurant

Sunday, September 13, 2026

8:15 AM	Staff arrives at quarry for set up
8:45 AM	Lodging check out and departure for quarry
9:00 AM	Arrive at quarry and get armband, repeat process from yesterday
9:30 AM	Begin diving day
11:00 AM	Logbooks & snack time
Noon	Final certification paperwork, logbook completion, and group photo
1:00 PM	Pack up and head for home

**Please Note:**

- Students will be asked to carry the gear that will be needed for the trip, this is part of the training.
- We will provide iced drinking water, continental breakfast, and light snacks for Saturday. Please bring your own specialty foods. There will be food available for purchase onsite- bring CASH
- You might also like to bring folding camp chairs to use in addition to our picnic table. Under no circumstances is gear to be placed on the picnic tables. That area is reserved for our picnic lunch and logbooks.
- **PLEASE** use the equipment checklist, part of being a diver is learning to be self-sufficient by packing and preparing properly!
- Dives will be held rain or shine (obviously times may be edited if the storms produce thunder & lightning)

**Equipment Checklist**

- Specialty drinks, snacks, and lunch for Saturday if you don't want to buy barbecue from Cowboy who cooks on a grill all day
- BCD
- Regulator with compass
- Tank and weights
- Wetsuit – a lightweight full suit
- Mask, snorkel, fins
- Logbook, pen, dive table or dive computer
- Towels, and protective clothes
- Sunscreen, hat, sunglasses
- Insect repellent, swimmers ear preparation, mask anti fog
- Folding chair
- **Beanie for your head protection from nibbling fish**

It is very important for every diver to go online and complete the information form prior to quarry entry, failure to do so results in LONG delays and will hold up our entire dive group.
