

Optional - allows you to have a small pattern or image repeat vertically, horizontally or both to fill up the entire bar if needed.

Optional - allows you to stretch an image vertically, horizontally or both if desired to take up the entire bar space.

Position of the image on the bar noticeable if not centered or stretched.

Optional to set the transparency of the bar to allow you to be able to see through it. 100% is solid 10% is most see-thru.

Standard WP editor for content box content. Pretty much same as notification bar but the more option is not needed.

Note: As of now shortcodes may or may not work depending how the other plugin is configured. Having two WP editors on one page seems to cause problems for certain plugins shortcodes to be recognized.

Opacity 50% Overlay transparency level. The note about having to use 100% transparency isn't necessarily true. You can most likely set any opacity level and still have it lock. Make sure you test it with all browsers. Any issues were usually with IE. If you experience any try changing the http:// to https:// for the source of the embed video within the embed code.

for locked content, an overlay will be placed over the content, and if there's a video within the content, it will be locked as well.

Select a bar from the dropdown menu you want to use on that page or post. If you don't want to select a different bar for different countries then simply select the bar you want to use in "all countries"

Leave it on default if you want it to pick up the bar selected in the settings menu.


