

## How to re-brand your plugin.

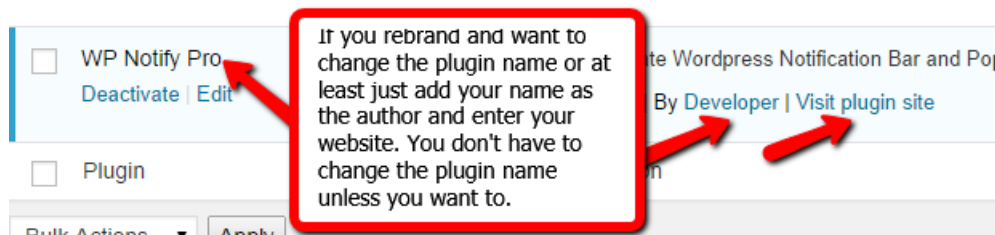
In this document I will show you how to rebrand your plugin if you want to. It's all optional but depending on how you want to sell or market your plugin you may want to do things like put your name in as the author, update the links to point to your sites so it's branded to you in the WP plugin menu.

Or if you want to rebrand the plugin to be a completely different plugin name and market it as a new and different plugin you can do that as well. What you modify is up to you here's how you can do it.

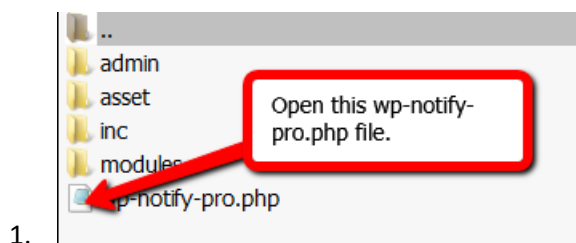
**Note:** Be sure to make a copy of your plugin before you modify anything in case you mess it up you will have a backup.

**Warning:** You will have to modify a couple of file names etc. but do not modify anything else besides what I show you or you can cause your plugin to stop working properly.

**First, if you want to change your plugin name, author name and URLs in the plugin menu:**

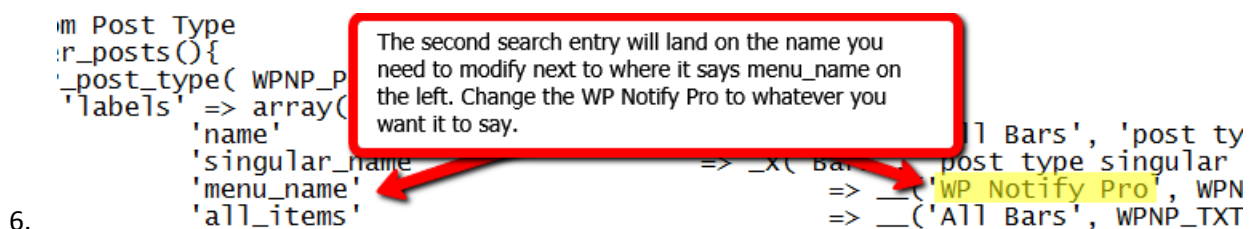
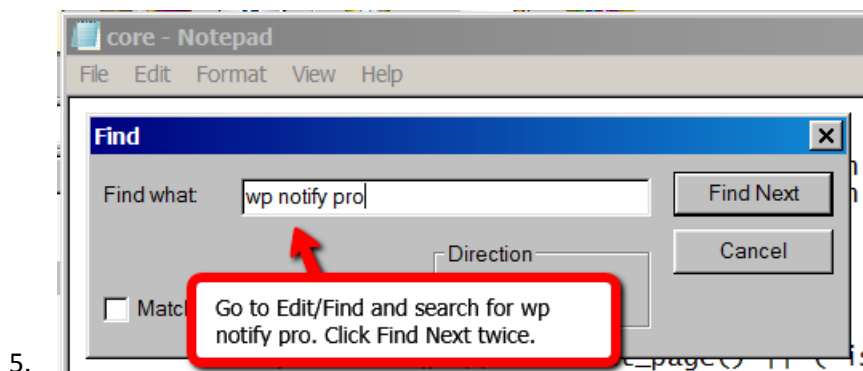
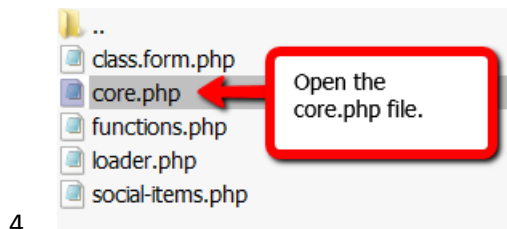
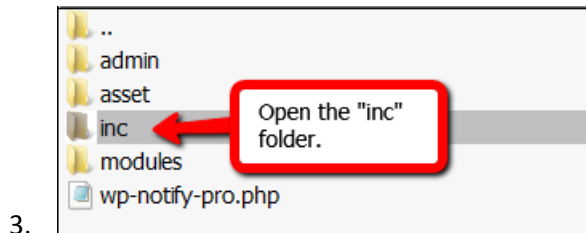
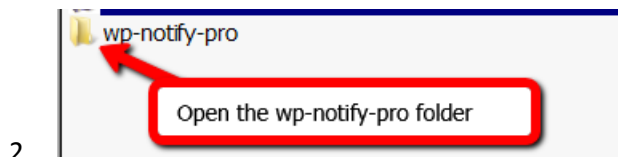


**Summary:** you'll need to open the plugin archive, browse to the wp-notify-pro.php file and open it. Then you can modify the entries in the top of the document to your info.

7. Save and exit that file and then close the archive. Once you upload the plugin the menu name will be changed.
