

# How To Setup Auto-Responder

## Short Guide To Integrate AR With FB Connect

You can optionally have the lead be automatically opted into your list with a third party service like Aweber, MailChimp, IContact, etc.

If you don't have this setup, you can automatically redirect the lead to any URL you wish. If you do NOT want to have this option, please make sure the **"Auto-Responder Web Form Code"** is blank with nothing in it...

\*\* This tutorial will be using Aweber, but its basically the same thing for any AR service...

## Step #1: Creating the web form

You need to setup the web form inside of Aweber...

First, you will need to create a web form inside of aweber, or your AR service.

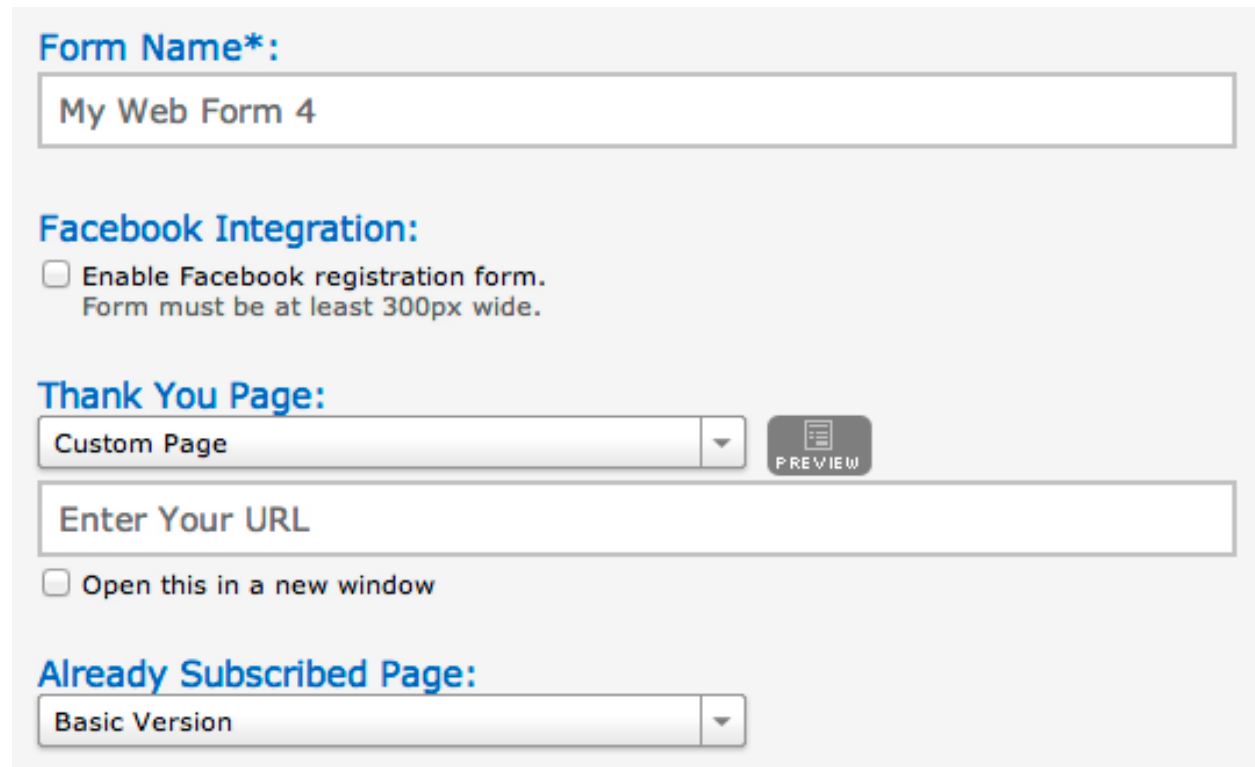
Create A New Web Form

Each AR service is different on how they let you create the web form, but we only need to have a simple form with the **full name field FIRST and then the email field second**. It must be in that order.

Most AR services already have this setup, like Aweber, you don't need to touch anything as its already in this order...

Now go to "Settings" for the web form:

In the settings for Aweber, you can give the form a name, but whats important is the Thank You page. Since we are using a AR integration, the redirect URL inside of the button settings will be overwritten with this URL. ( keep that in mind )

So set up the redirect URL there.

\*\* Aweber users, please make sure the Facebook Integration is UNCHECKED, if this is checked, the plugin will not be able to use the web code...

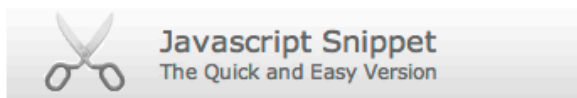
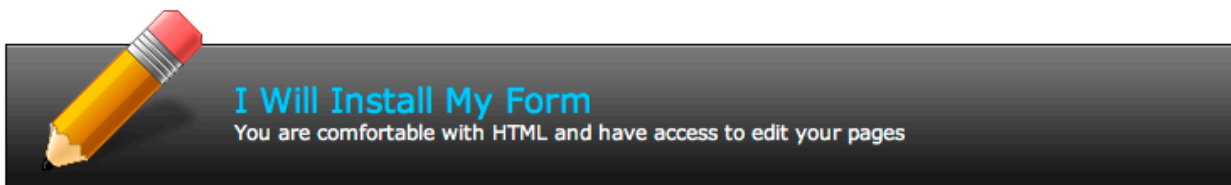
## Step #2: Get the Web Form Code

You need to copy all of the web form code...

Now that you have the web form created, you need to get the web form code. Inside of aweber, you can get the RAW HTML VERSION, and you MUST get a raw html version of the code.

Or else the plugin will not be able to use the web form code.

Simply grab all of the code they give you. Note, the appearance of your form doesn't matter, as the form the users opt into is invisible...



### For Those Comfortable with Raw HTML:

- Easily customizable to fit any scenario.
- Track statistics in your account.

## Step #3: Paste the Web Form Code

Paste the web form code into the button settings...

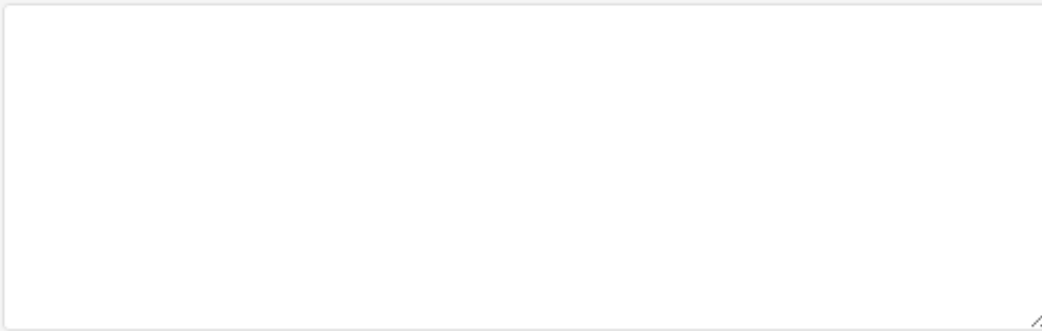
Once you have the web form code copied, you will need to go back the button settings area inside of the plugin. Then paste in the code where it says “**Auto-Responder Web Form Code:**”

#### **Auto-Responder Web Form Code:**

Paste in your web form code here and automatically it will integrate the code...

Once you do this, it automatically take the webform and break it apart and enter in the name, email, form post, and hidden areas. If you are an advance users then you can edit these areas. If you are not, then do NOT touch them...

You should see something like this, after you paste in the code:

*( if you don't, try clicking inside the Auto-Responder Web Form Code field, and hitting enter to trigger the action )*

Once you have done this, and you see something similar to what you see below. Just hit Save Button Changes and test out your new button!

**That's it!**

### Name Field:

This will be the field where the full name is captured...

### Email Field:

This will be the field where the email addressed is captured...

### Form POST URL:

This will be the URL of where the form will post too ( for advance users )...

### Hidden Fields:

This will be the hidden fields ( for advance users )...
