

How To Setup Facebook App

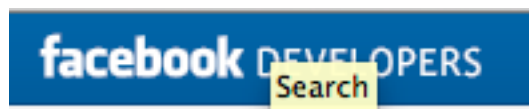
Short Guide On Setting Up a Facebook App

For each button you setup, you can have a different Facebook app connected to it, or just the same Facebook app for each button. The benefit of using a different FB app for each button is that you can customize what the “FB connect” screen looks like with a different text.

However, you can setup on FB app, and use it for all your buttons...

Step #1: Creating a FB App

Creating the facebook application...

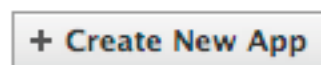


First, you need to go to **developers.facebook.com** and create a developers account. You can do this with your own FB account, you will be asked to confirm your account with either a cell phone call / text or a credit card.

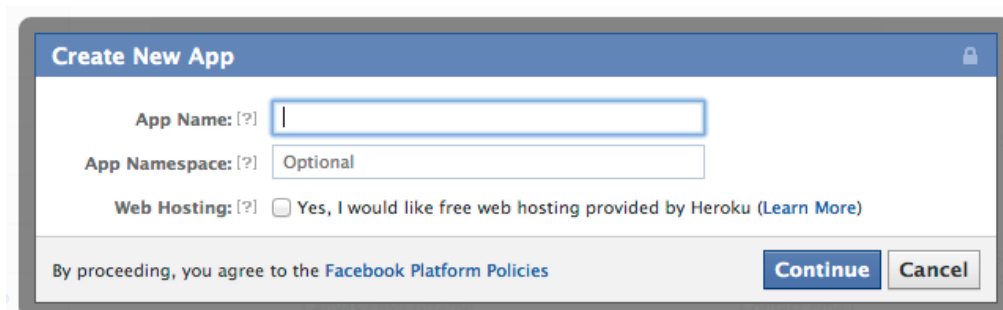
Once you have a developer account, you can go to “**Apps**”:



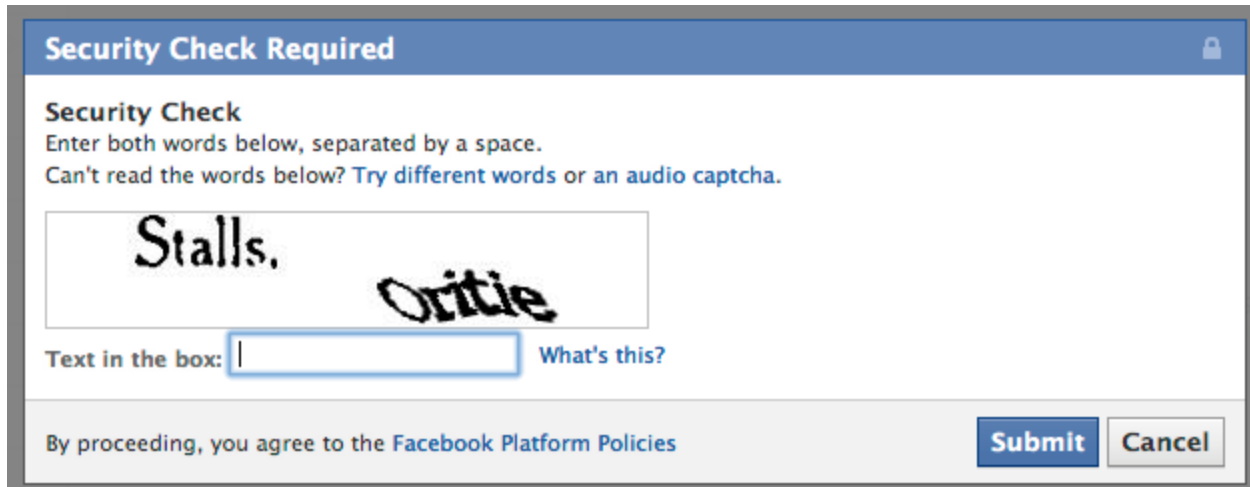
And you can view all your apps that you have created. You will now need to click on the “**Create New App**” button:



Once you have done that, you should see a pop up. Like this:

You will need to enter in a App Name, the rest is optional. After you hit continue, you will be asked to fill in a captcha:

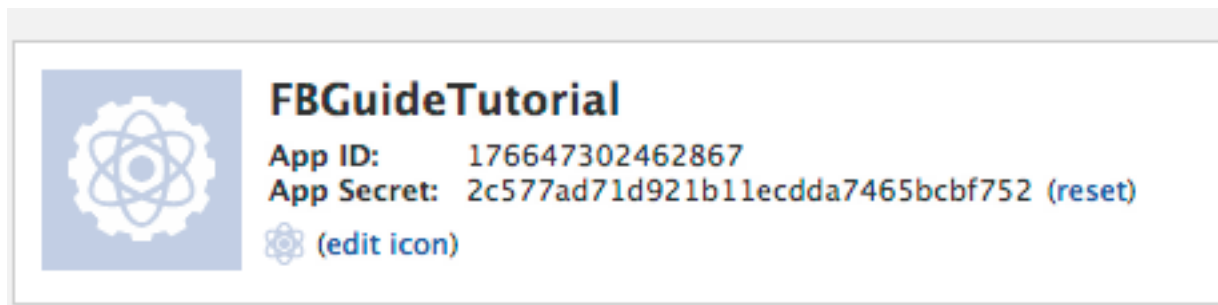
Please note, in this example, we called our App : **FBGuideTutorial**

Step #2: Getting Your ID & Secret Code

Setting your important info inside of the plugin...

Now that you have a new Facebook App created, you will now need to briefly copy and paste your App ID & App Secret into the FB settings area inside of the button settings.

To find your App ID & App Secret, it will be on the main screen inside of your FB app:

Grab those two pieces of information, and paste them into your button settings. You will see a place for the App ID and one for the App Secret. Please make sure there is no spaces before or after of the codes when you enter it. As it could cause some issues.

Facebook App Settings

This is the Facebook app secret code you get when you create an app...

Step #3: Adding Your Domain

Setting up your App Domain...

You almost have the Facebook app configured correctly, however, you will need to do two more step.

First, you need to add your domain to the **App Domains**:

App Domains: [?]	<input type="text" value="yoursite.com x"/>

Inside of the “**Basic Info**” for your FB app, you will see an area called “**App Domains**” and you need to enter in your domain.

You can see I have “yoursite.com” as an example. You want to enter it like that, without www. or http://. Just the actual domain of your site. If you are using a sub-domain like “blog.yoursite.com” then add that to the App Domain.

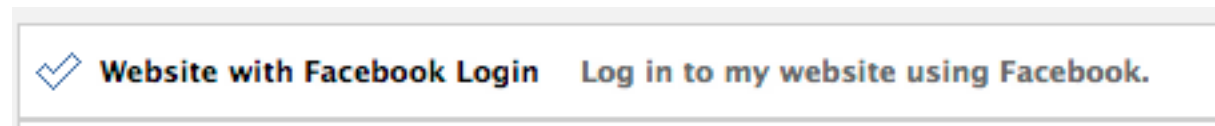
Also, its important to press enter after you have put in your domain. The light blue box will appear around your domain. Then just hit “**Save Changes**”...

Step #4: Adding Your Site URL

Setting up your Site URL inside of Facebook App...

This is the final step, and then your already ready to go!

You need to tell your FB App to go to a special URL once the user has connected with facebook. You should see a section called “Website With Facebook Login” inside of your FB app Settings:



Click on that to activate it. Since we are adding a Facebook login to our page, but we wont be using it as a login, but more as a opt in. :)

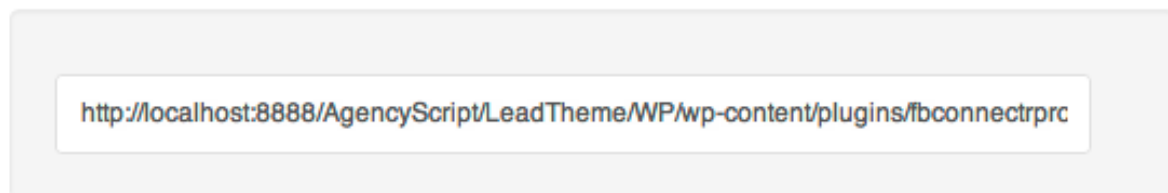
Once you click on that, you will see it turn blue, and ask you for your Site URL, like this:



To get your Site URL, you need to go back the plugin, go to settings, and you should see this area:

FB Settings: Your Site URL

When you set up your Facebook App, you will be asked for a site URL, you need to enter this:



Copy and paste that URL, and paste it into your Site URL inside of your FB App settings. This URL is where they go once they connect, and this page will save their info and opt them into the form.

Then your done and ready go to!
