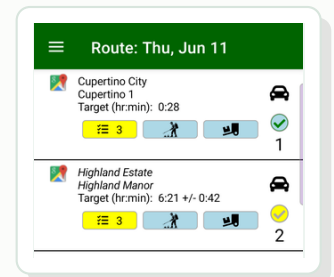
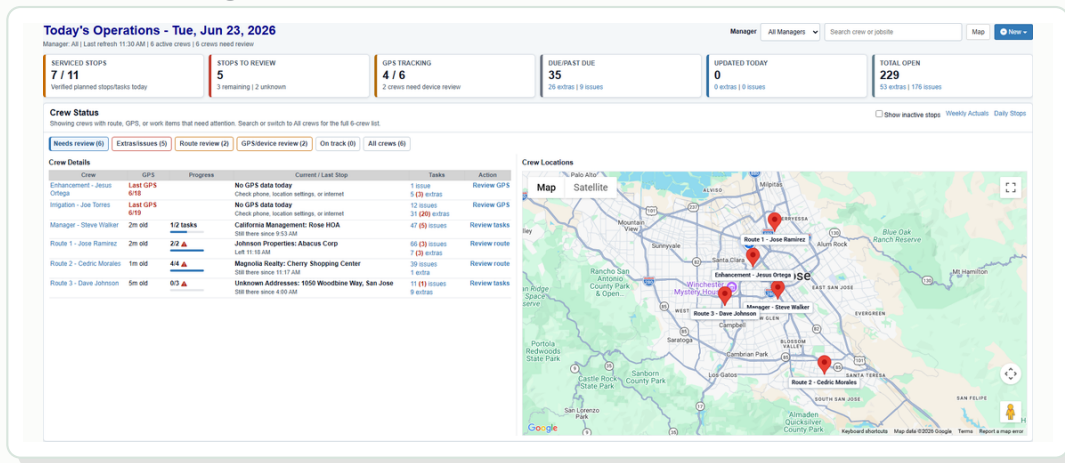

Labor, materials, follow-up, and billing signals stay visible.

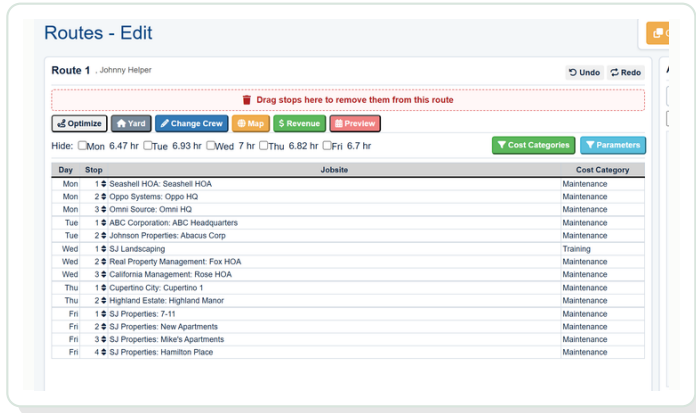


ONE WORKDAY, WITHOUT THE GAPS

1 PLAN THE WORK



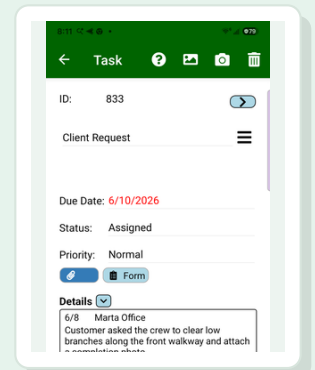
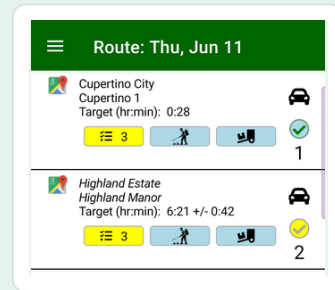
Build route plans the crew can run.

Field Manager lets the office assign crews, balance route days, and keep customer and jobsite details current before dispatch.

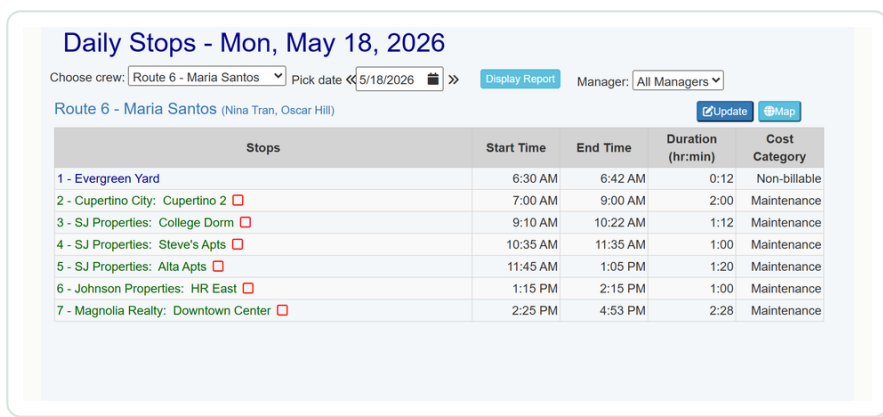
2 WORK THE DAY

See GPS-Recorded Stops and Time at Site.

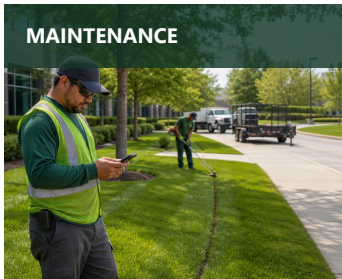
