### Fairness Pillar

We are learning about fairness! The Fairness Pillar is orange.

#### Here are some things you can do at home:

- **Make a Fairness Pillar.** You can use the Pillar on the back of this page. You and your child can color or paint the Pillar orange. Put the Pillar somewhere you will see it often. Talk about how it reminds us to be fair.
- **Fair share.** When you are dividing things at home, talk about being fair. You can do this when you are serving food or when you are dividing play dough between children.
- **Being fair throughout the day.** Often, children complain that something is not fair. They may want to sit in a special chair all of the time or use a certain cup. This is a great time to talk about being fair. You can also make a chart or picture to show children how you are being fair. For example, if two children want to sit in the same chair every day, let them know you want to be fair. You want to make sure they both have equal time sitting in the special chair.
  - Show the children you are going to write their names on the calendar so they will know when it is their day to sit in the special chair. Remind the children to look at the calendar so they know where they will be sitting that day.
- **Learn a poem.** Here is a poem about fairness. You might say each line and then help your child say the last word of the line.

Fair is the way I want to be.  
All my friends appreciate me.  
We all get the same.  
And no one's to blame.  
Fair is the way we want to be!
