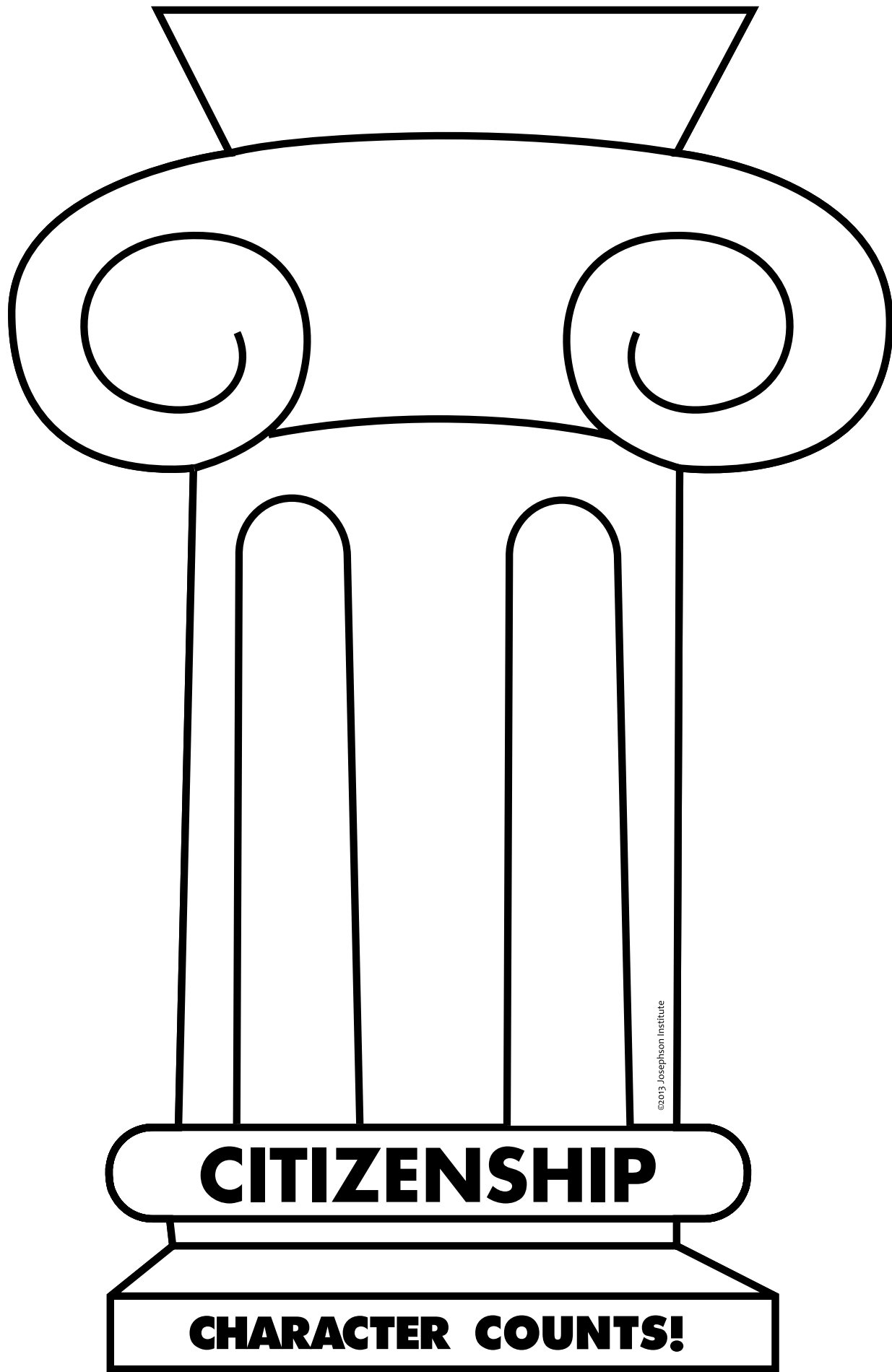
Citizenship Pillar

We are learning about citizenship! The Citizenship Pillar is purple. It reminds us to follow rules and to take care of the environment.

Here are some things you can do at home:

- **Make a Citizenship Pillar.** You can use the Pillar on the back of this page. You and your child can color or paint the Pillar purple. Put the Pillar where you will see it often. Talk about the Citizenship Pillar and how it helps us remember to follow rules and take care of the earth.
- **Recycle:**
 - Talk about recycling. This is a way we can help take care of the earth. This is being a good citizen.
 - Decide what you can recycle. Many families start with recycling paper.
 - Make a recycling box or bag. Find a box or paper bag to use for recycling. You and your child can decorate the box or bag.
 - Start filling your recycling bag or box!
 - Do you already recycle at home? Give yourself a pat on the back! Think of ways you might be able to recycle more. Think of ways you might help others start to recycle.
- **Learn a song about Citizenship.** Sing this song to the tune of “Are You Sleeping? (Frere Jacques).” Point to yourselves when the song says “I” and then point to each other when the song says “we.”
