Tower of Trust

We have been learning about being trustworthy. To help us learn, we made a Tower of Trust. Every time a child was trustworthy, they added a block to our block tower.

Here are some things you can do at home:

- **Talk with your child about being trustworthy.** Trustworthiness is doing what you say you will do. Think about ways you and your child show you are trustworthy at home. Some ideas might be:
 - telling the truth.
 - finishing a job you said you would do.
 - being honest when playing a game.
- **Make a Flower of Trust:**
 - Use the flower on the back of this page.
 - Each time someone in your family shows they are trustworthy, color a petal of the flower.
 - When all the petals are colored, hang the flower in a place you will see it often.
 - Here are more ideas if your child needs help understanding trustworthiness.
 - Put a pile of toys on the floor and tell your child that you have made a mess! Then say that you are going to be trustworthy. Start putting the toys away. Each time a toy is put away, ask your child to color a petal of the flower because you did what you said you would do.
 - You can make more flowers. Draw a flower on a piece of paper. Color the petals. Cut out petal shapes from plain paper or magazine pages. For the center of the flower, draw a circle on a piece of paper. Glue or tape a petal to the paper each time a member of the family shows they are trustworthy.
