KCMBA Launches Headquarters Improvements and Naming Rights Opportunities

Kansas City Metropolitan Bar Association (KCMBA) is pleased to announce a 13-year lease extension at KCMBA's Headquarters and Event Center, located on the first floor of 2300 Main, Kansas City, MO. Located in the heart of Kansas City, KCMBA's headquarters is neighbor to the new KC Streetcar, flourishing Arts District and a slew of restaurants, hotels and independent businesses opening in the area. The move to this location in 2010 significantly elevated the level of service provided members and the greater Kansas City legal community as a whole. With the extended lease, KCMBA will continue to offer free parking and a special member benefit of reduced rates for space rental. In addition, there are new opportunities for members of the community to contribute and be recognized for their generosity.

In addition to the current rooms and conference center, the following improvements will be added this summer:

- A new conference room with seating for 12 and a view that includes the iconic Western Auto sign
- Enlargement of the Boardroom to include more room for social engagement and a built-in refreshment center with an icemaker, filtered hot/cold water dispenser, and an under-counter refrigerator
- A new private wellness room with comfortable seating, a sink and refrigerator
- A new huddle room with table seating for four
- Privatization of and significant improvements to the existing patio space adjoining our facility to the north, including a beautiful view of downtown
- And much more

With these planned enhancements, KCMBA is offering additional opportunities to contribute and be recognized with new naming right options for many new spaces and opportunities that were not previously offered, along with a new donor recognition wall to allow more firms and individuals the opportunity to be a part of our enhanced facilities. Rights are offered on a *first-come, first-served basis* to all members of the legal community. After construction is complete, many of the new and renovated areas will also be available to firms and businesses looking to rent space for meetings, depositions, mediations, arbitrations and other events. .
