Missionary Highlight: Walter & Claire McConnell

Dear Friends at Keyport Bible Church,

It was wonderful to have time with you back in July. It was so good to be able to share more about our work here in Singapore and to catch up with what has been happening with many of you.

The OMF International Center in Singapore can at times be a very hectic place with many people coming and going for training and other reasons. We returned to just such a time with the New Workers' Orientation Course just finishing and preparation for the International Directors' face-to-face meetings underway. Walter uses this opportunity to discuss current issues with the Directors. Now that we live at the center it is much easier to have folks over to our flat for a meal, or catch someone for coffee and a chat. This is a real blessing for us, but also an opportunity to give a listening ear and friendship to our busy leaders. Please pray for this part of our ministry. (By the way, the next New Workers' Orientation is 20 Oct- 20 Nov and we still need people to help with the children and IT. E-mail us if you are interested.)

Walter has been busy editing and writing for the next issue of our journal focusing on ministering to East Asians living outside their home countries. Claire has also written an article for this issue. Pray for the work of layout and proofreading that will take place over the next few weeks. Pray that the issue will be printed before a major meeting in Thailand for all our leaders so we can bring copies with us for distribution.

Each morning the Center begins with 30 minutes of devotional and prayer for one of our countries of ministry. Pray for Walter and I as we each prepare once a month to lead this time. May we bring encouragement and challenge through the devotional and also clear information to help us pray effectively for each of the countries in which we work.

Walter has preached twice this month and will preach four more times before Christmas. He really enjoys preaching; pray that the Lord will use him to challenge and encourage many.

We will be in Thailand for three weeks from 10-29 September. The first week we will visit a number of OMF ministries in Bangkok and Central Thailand. Pray that we can learn and understand more about the challenges of church planting in these areas. The second week we will attend a major consultation of our leadership. Pray for those bringing the messages and leading discussion. Pray that we may all know the Lord's guidance as we listen and discuss important topics together. The third week we will visit the OMF work in North East Thailand, an area which has the lowest density of Christians in the country.

Thank you for your interest in our work, your partnership with us through your continued prayers and financial support.
