## Missionary Highlight: Walter & Claire McConnell

Dear Friends, Although it is a couple of weeks into the Year of the Dog, we want to wish you all a happy lunar New Year. Thank you so much for praying for us during our time at the South East Asia Theological Seminary in Indonesia. Though it was exhausting, Walter got through all of his lectures in Mandarin. He now has to mark three sets of papers for seventeen students before we head off for Chiang Mai on 23 March. All of these papers are in simplified Chinese characters while Walter studied the traditional!

We spent today planning future work in the archives. It is encouraging to see the progress that has been made, but daunting to see what has yet to be done. Pray that we will find some volunteers to help with some of the work.

A major setback at the moment is that Claire's computer has not been working properly since mid-February. This has slowed her down as she has to borrow a computer. It is a major frustration that has stumped many IT people. Pray that the problems will be solved soon.

In mid-February, when we flew up to Chiang Mai, we were encouraged by our visit to the archives at Payap University. We were given a wonderful tour of the excellent facility that holds some of OMF's material about ministry in Thailand. It is good to know that our history is part of an extensive resource for the study of the history of the church in Thailand that can be used by Thai and foreign researchers for many years.

While in Chiang Mai, we had good talks with two field leaders about their ministries and about research in their areas. We also had some lovely surprises as we met friends who are serving in other parts of Asia who "happened" to be in Chiang Mai for holiday or training. We then joined a field conference for people who serve the church in China. It was good to hear their stories and to get to know the challenges they are facing due to the recent changes in the laws pertaining to NGOs and foreign businesses, and the new religious laws that took effect on 1 February. Pray for wisdom for the church in China in this new environment. Pray also for those whose visas have been effected.
