Since they left, the Dad, too, has come to a saving knowledge of Christ as a result of the changed life of his boy. This ‘boy’ in the coonskin hat now is working in our clubs. It would have been hard to imagine this fidgety boy so eager to learn more of God’s Word and to serve, yet today he is teaching and reaching boys and girls who sit in the very place where he first heard about the Savior.”
