Greetings Keyport Brothers and Sisters,

Dave Spoon, COTN Resource/Events Project Coordinator, Spiritual Care specialist for Sierra Leone, Malawi, and Uganda.

Since returning from Sierra Leone at the end of May 2017, there has been a change in my position with Children of the Nations. I am also helping with managing resources, meal packaging events, and arranging the moving of freight/resources to container loading events around the USA. My first 8 years I was involved with some of these things at COTN. I am now working on my 12th year with COTN!

I will still be involved with spiritual care in Sierra Leone, Malawi, and Uganda. I plan to go to at least one of these countries every year and help with mentoring, discipleship, and supporting the churches. Tanya's Manette Clinic is really growing fast and she will be busy here in the USA. Her clinic has been a great mission here in Bremerton, but pray she continues to get the help she needs so she can be freed up to travel to Africa with me in the future.

Pray for the spiritual care leaders in our countries who are making an impact in our ministry areas in Jesus's name! Many of these leaders are children who grew up in COTN homes and have been supported by you!

Please pray for the church in sub-Saharan Africa. There is growth, but there is also confusion. People are desperate for resources to survive, and sometimes seek their needs through bad theology or the witch doctor/false prophet. I try to continue to connect daily with our African countries to support them in their work.

The Spoons miss all of you at Keyport Bible, and appreciate all your love and support. God is doing amazing things in the lives of our orphans. Many are graduating university.
