It has been challenging for us to do everyday tasks, but we are thankful for the beauty and peace winter scenes bring. Below you will find updates and prayer requests for our work here in Croatia. We are delighted to finally finish the publication of John MacArthur's Commentary on the Book of Hebrews in Croatian. It is a labor of love by so many - from the generous supporters to translators and editors. Thank you for praying for this much needed volume. We look forward to seeing how God will use this book to help pastors from former Yugoslavia in their preaching and teaching to God's people.

Kris went to California for TMAI (The Master's Academy International) meetings and to attend the Shepherds Conference at the end of February. We are thankful for the like-minded church leaders with whom he could share the burden of evangelizing the unreached in all of the world. While there, he was also able to meet with his doctoral studies advisor who has been very encouraging about the progress of his thesis.

Our oldest, Gracie, was able to accompany Kris to California to finalize her plans to attend The Master's University in the fall. They met with financial advisors, admissions office staff, and professors, and had their many questions answered. The trip just confirmed in Gracie's heart that it's where she wants to start her college journey.

They live right across the street from campus, so Gracie will not even need a car. This was an answer to prayer. Not only will they be providing for her physical needs, but they will care for her in other ways, such as discipleship, mentoring and accountability while we are halfway around the world. What a blessing and comfort this is to us as her parents! Truly, God works in unexpected ways that always leave us in awe of His goodness. And we are continually amazed by the blessings we receive through His people.
