1961 Don and Joanne Strunk (new missionaries with NICE) came to Pastor at Keyport.

1962 Roy and Elvia Sprague were invited to conduct evangelistic meetings and Vacation Bible School at Keyport.

1963 Keyport Bible Church committed support to Strunks as they became the second Director of NICE.

1970 Keyport Bible Church was one of the first churches to respond to support Spragues as the third Director of NICE.

1982 Bob and Katherine Rodgers were commissioned by Keyport Bible Church and sent out as missionaries to serve at Culatesac, Idaho – and then again in 1996 to Calvary Bible Church in Hailey, Idaho.

2000 Keyport Bible Church added Earl and Shirley Brubaker as supported missionaries when they became the Mission's new Director.

2010 Keyport Bible Church continue to support Bob and Katherine Rodgers as they responded by faith to become NICE's 5th Director.
