Dear Saints at Keyport,

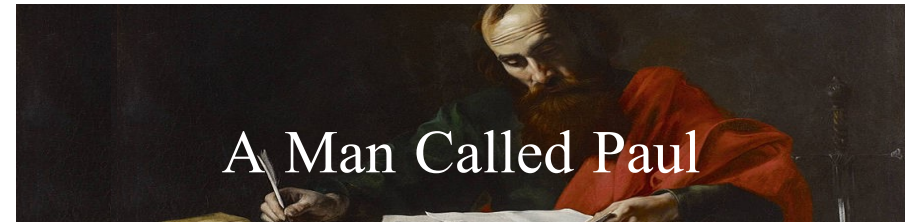
As always, we appreciate the opportunity to highlight the Lord's work here in Southwest Colorado! Below are some requests we would be grateful to have your prayers for.
