We are retired in Gresham, OR, but still in good health and active in ministry. We have made three trips to Alaska in the last 3 months to do funerals for supporters and fellow workers.

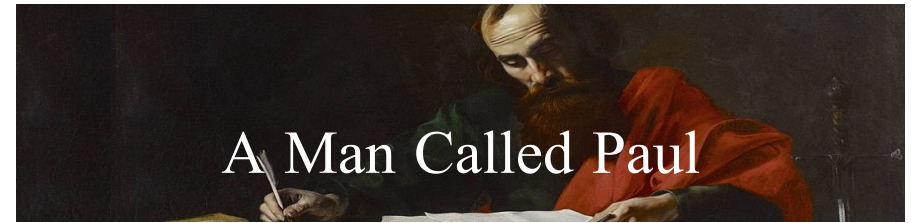
Pray for the many different opportunities we have to do consulting with our mission InterAct ministries. The mission has a good number of new missionaries. Pray for the training and placement of these.
