-Please pray for our Summer staff needs. We have a few more people signed up than we did this time last year, but we are still lacking a lot of staff!

-Last week, the director woke up to low water pressure. When the water company made it out in the afternoon, they found out camp was losing 14 GPM somewhere! Chase had to try to find a water line break under 2 feet of snow on 20 acres. He was able to locate the water leak after about 5 hours of looking. We felt that it was way easier to find than we anticipated! He had to dig down and then around quite a bit to find it, but he was able to find it! It is now repaired, and camp is up and running again!

-Chase is working to try and get the first side of the boys' bathhouse done before camp starts. With all the snow plowing he has been doing, in combination with this water line break, he hasn't gotten as much done on that project as he would like. Please pray that we will get all we can done on it before camp starts, and that we will trust the Lord and His perfect timing in this!

-The truck Chase got this summer has proven far more worn out than we anticipated and we are not in a position to fix it or purchase a different one. We have decided to sell this truck and trust God to provide in this area. This is the first time Chase will be without a work truck since we began working at camp. Please pray that God would provide a reliable work truck and that Chase would be able to make the most of working out of the car in the meantime.
