Dear KBC,

We praise the Lord to be able to partner with Keyport Bible Church in your worldwide outreach of the Gospel. Our ministry these days is mainly focused on the Philippines.

The following are a few items of info and for prayer:

1. Continue to pray for Pastor Guy's ministry to needy pastors in the Philippines this October at the Pastoral Care Conference. We expect about 250 pastors.
2. Pray as we seek to have a set of 9-11 free theology books for each pastor attending the conference. Four of these books will be printed, with a budget need of \$1500 per book.
3. Many additional missionaries are needed and requested to serve among the 105 million people of the country with over 95 million not knowing the Gospel.
4. We have several evangelistic children's camps and seminars for pastors scheduled over the next 6-8 weeks. Much planning to do. Please trust the Lord with us for His supply of all that's needed.
5. We are having health difficulties in our old age (I fell and now suffer for it with possible surgery needed) which of course slows us down with side effects of painful, sleepless nights (only three hours last night). But God is faithful and we can trust Him.
