

Missionary Highlight: Doug & Margaret Nichols

Dear Keyport Bible Church,

Margaret and I thank you again for the opportunity to partner with the church and your outreach of the Gospel in worldwide missions to the glory of God!

The following is a brief update for information and prayer:

1. I returned home mid-September to South Carolina after a weekend of ministry in Chicago speaking in a conference and attending several appointments with publishers and others for the Philippines. (Margaret was not able to accompany me as she injured her foot and could not walk).

2. Tyndale House Publisher gave us nearly \$25,000 - \$30,000 value of slightly damaged bibles and books for ministry in the Philippines! Our cost is only the cost of shipping to Seattle and then to repack and ship to the Philippines (total shipping cost of perhaps \$1800).

3. Please pray for final preparations for our yearly Pastoral Care Conference in the Philippines (October 8-11) for 225-250 pastors who will be traveling from throughout the country.

4. Pray for Margaret as she prepares to speak soon at a women's meeting on "Contentment in Jesus."

5. Thank you for praying for strength in ministry, especially as we get older and weaker (Margaret is 74 as of the 25th of September, and I'm 77). We have difficulty moving quickly in our work with Margaret's foot problem, and me with bad legs and an injured shoulder.

6. There is much to do with preparation for special outreach in the next few months for ministry to the 200,000 street children of the Philippines and the 41,000 needy untrained pastors.

Thank you again for your support and prayer.
