After working with Action for ten years or so, the Lord has directed me to move to a NEW Mission Organization . This organization is called: Commission To Every Nation or CTEN. They have a great missionary care program which includes accountability and pastoral care. I have talked to my new Pastor care couple and we will be checking in with each other via What's app. twice a month or more, depending on my needs.

In Lilongwe I will be partnering with Eagles Nest Christian Academy, heading up the special needs program development in cooperation with The Academy's Director Sir Chris Chapota. I'm excited about this for two reasons, one is that the school has a strong academic program to offer kids of any ability and secondly Chris and Pam have a genuinely dynamic love for Christ and education. It is exciting for me to partner with them here in Lilongwe. We will keep our present students and seek to add new ones to the program.

Because I am a CTEN missionary raising support to do the work God has equipped me to do in Lilongwe , Malawi. It is my responsibility to form a team of financial and prayer partners who will support the ministry work I will be doing through CTEN.
