Hello Keyport Bible Church,

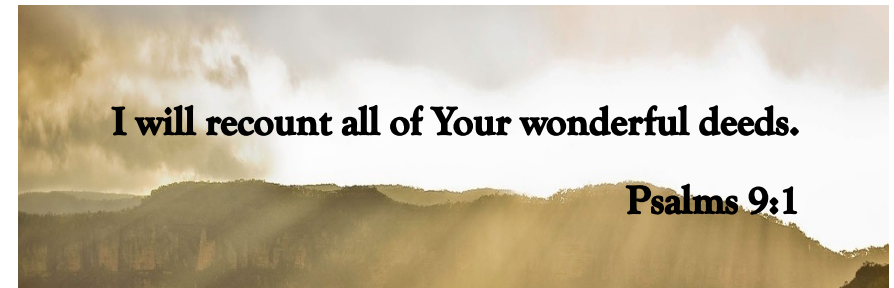
