Someone donated several computers to the ministry. They are packed with American Sign language lessons so the kids can learn at their own pace. Our teacher knows Malawian Sign language but that is a very limited language so she wants to learn more language with the Kids. We are also developing the phone lessons.

Over the years I have become close friends with a couple godly men of character who are pastors or have been pastors. These two are now the Assistant to the President and Advisor to the First Lady. Pray for me as I continue to befriend, encourage and support these two men.

My girls are all doing very well. Christina and Faith just finish their last years term, early this month. We will start the new year in Mid October. I'm impressed with their education. It is so Christ Centered but demands a lot from the girls. Pray for them.

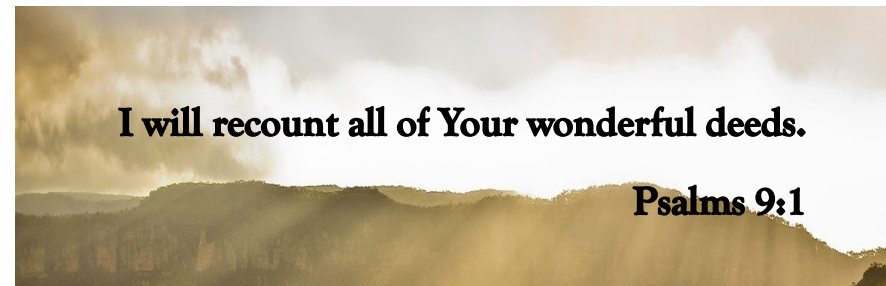
