Beach Renourishment Phase Two Underway

Phase Two of the Town's beach renourishment project began on Monday December 11. Crews are currently working near The Sandcastle and will be slowly moving east towards Mariner's Watch over the next two weeks. Please continue to avoid areas of the beach where construction crews are actively working.

Owners of private boardwalks along Eugenia Avenue are reminded that as the dune is rebuilt, portions of their boardwalk extending onto the active beach may be buried.



In November, Town Council approved ordinance changes on rental regulations and the application process. These changes will be implemented in the 2018 business license renewal season that begins next month. The Town is holding a brief presentation to review the ordinance changes and how it will impact persons and agencies that rent property on Kiawah. Preferred skill set should include:


- cultural arts background and expertise
