Position Responsibilities:

- Invest up to 25 hours per week in ministry
- Actively involved with Sunday morning services (playing or leading) (on stage 2-4 times a month) (5 Hours)
- Involved with weekly worship staff service planning. (Providing input on potential songs, scriptures, video, and other worship elements. Also, scheduling musicians) (5 Hours)
- Providing support in preparation of rehearsals. This includes preparing chord charts, copying music, setting up stage, setting up Ableton live tracks (3 Hours)
- Being active in youth worship ministry. Help the student worship coordinator plan and lead worship with students for street meetings. (when required)
- Meeting weekly for debrief of Sunday services and feedback with worship staff (2 Hours)
- Practice for youth worship and Sunday morning worship (2 hours)
- Participate in song writing sessions with Worship Ministry Staff (2 hours)
- Develop personal and professional goals (for internship) and pursue them
- Maintain a positive outlook and willingness to try new things as they arise
- Have exposure to tech ministry

Accountability: This worship intern position will report to the Pastor of Contemporary Worship and will also receive instruction from Pastor of Worship & Care and other worship ministry staff.
